**Mrs. B. Kalpana, HOD, professor, department of community health nursing,** Sree Narayana nursing college, has enlightened regarding the general assessment

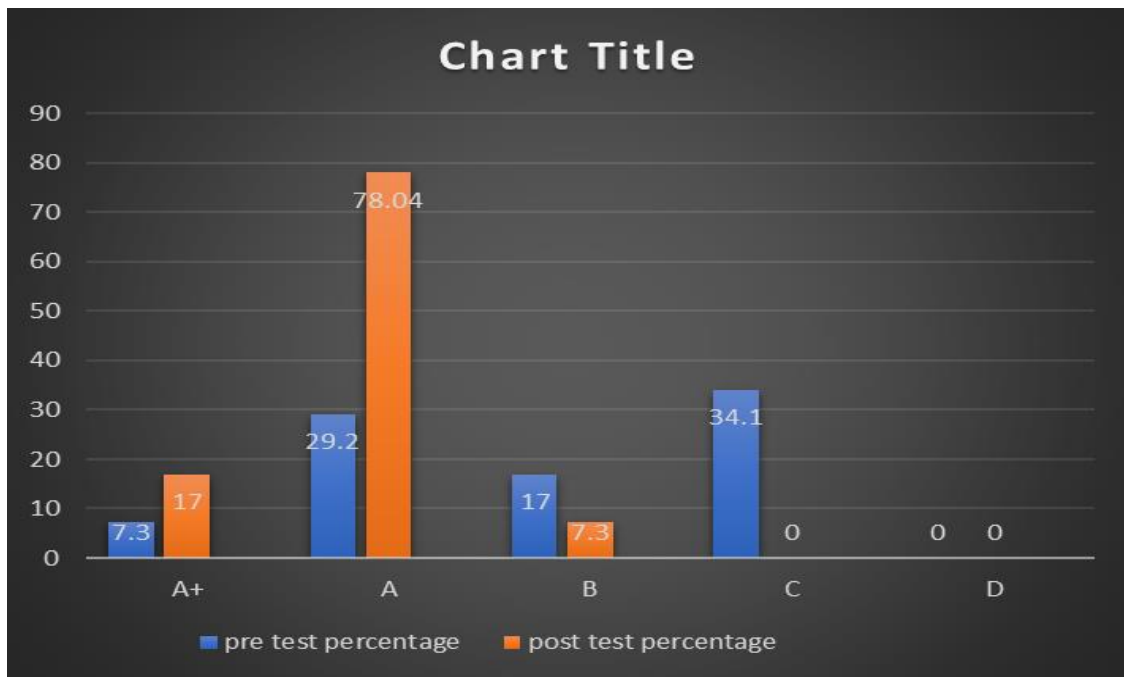
Mrs. A. Latha, HOD, professor, department of medical surgical nursing, Narayana college of nursing, has discussed regarding the assessment of each body system.

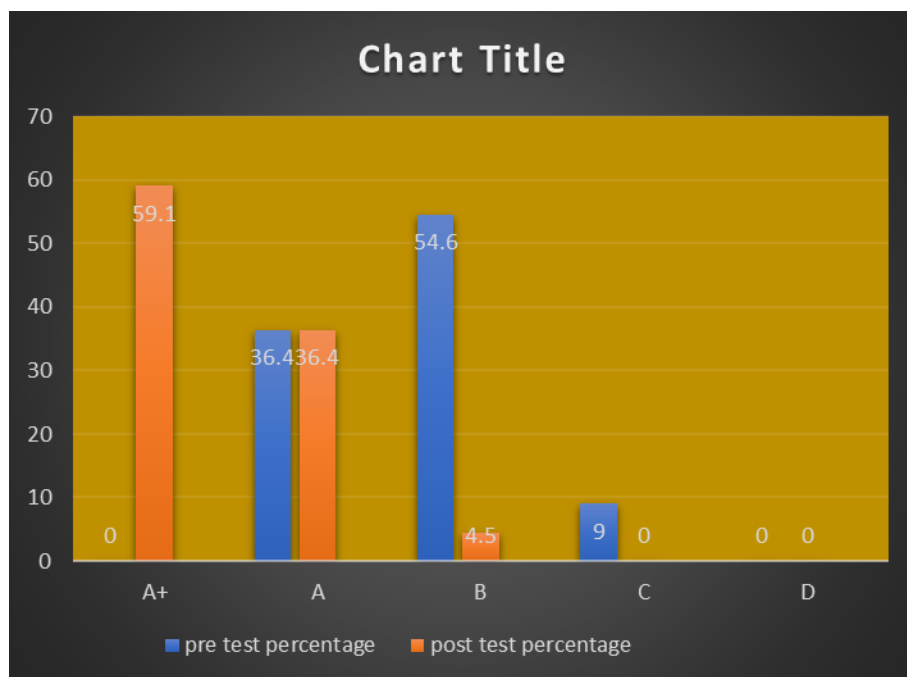


**Fig.No 1: Comparison of percentage distribution of level of knowledge on health assessment**

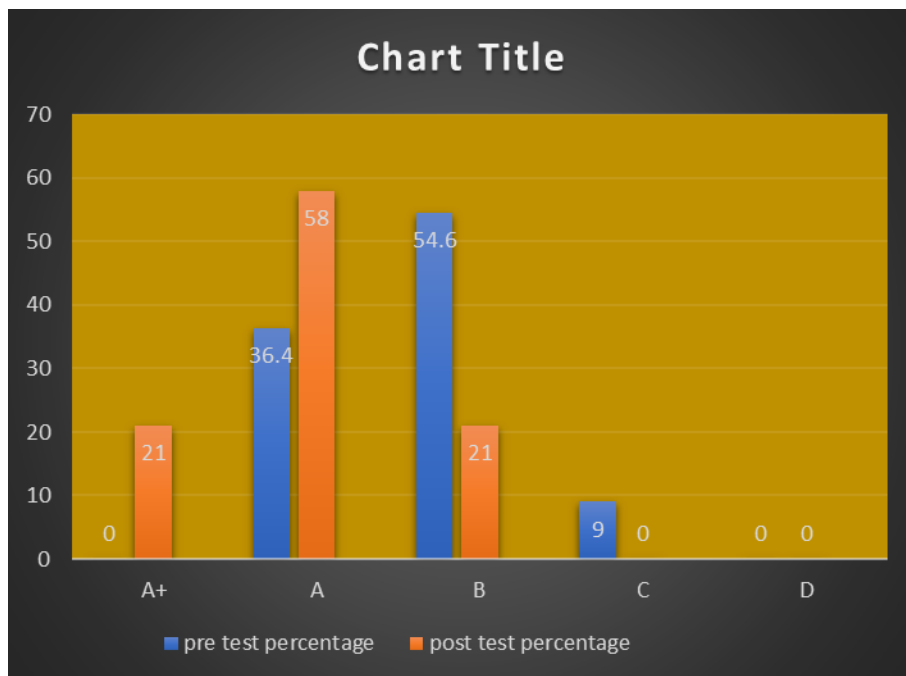
