Where as in post test, 18 (45 %) were having A+ grade knowledge, 12(30 %) were having A grade knowledge, 10(25%) were having B+ grade knowledge.

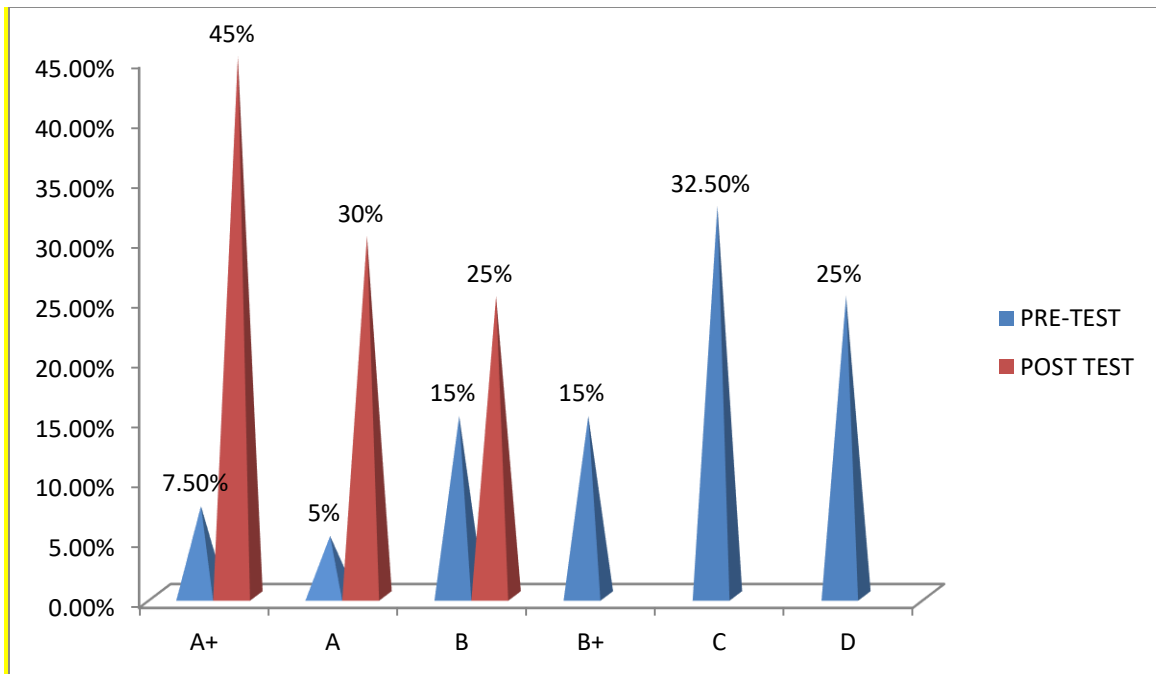


Fig-1: Comparison of Pre Test & Post Test Scores among Nursing Faculty

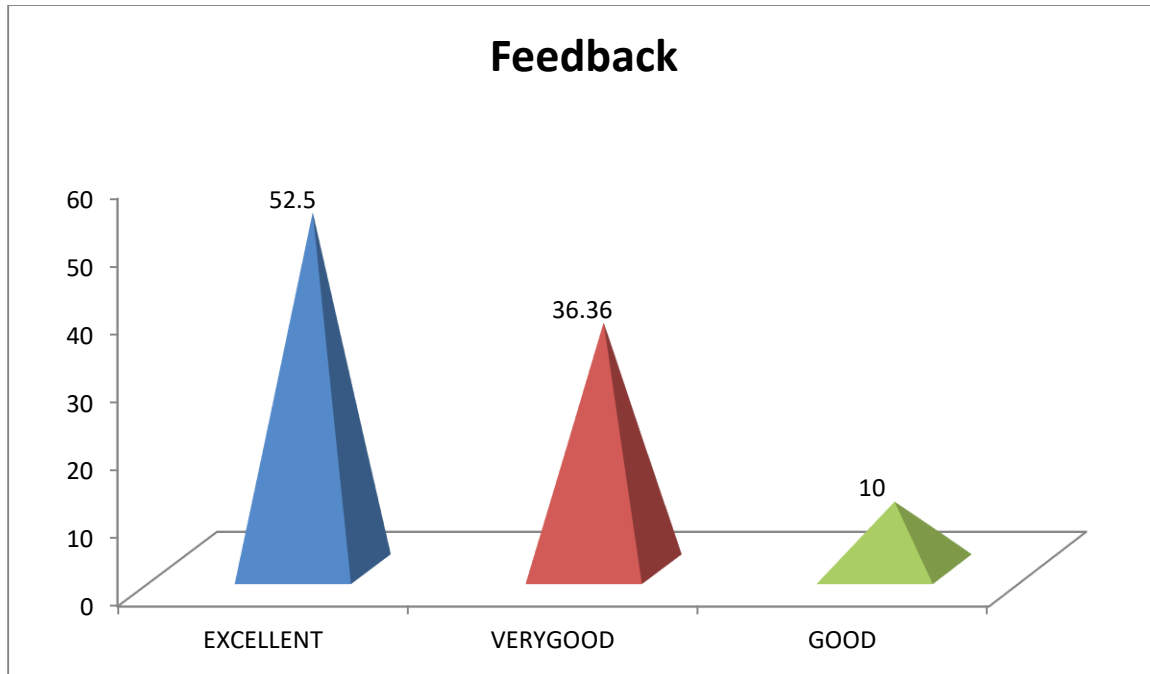


Fig-2: FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AMONG NURSING FACULTY
