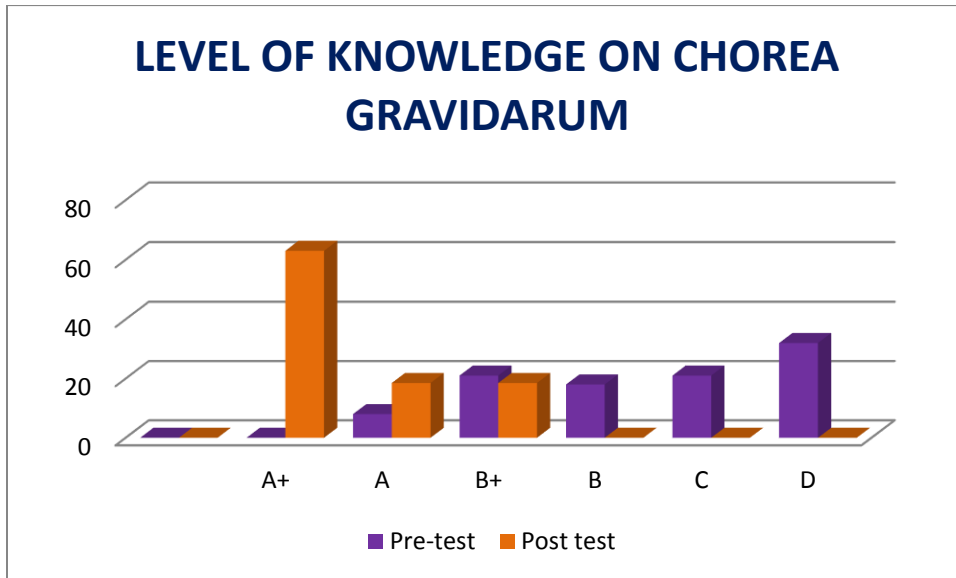
Causes and risk factors of chorea and choreogavidaram were explained in detailed manner by Ms .Revathi followed by discussion on **Pathophysiology** by Mrs.Ushakiran .Mrs Aruna gave a detailed discussion on **Signs and Symptoms and Diagnostic procedure** with supportive LCD presentation . **Prognosis ,management and follow up for choreagravidarum** were well presented by Mrs.P. Latha and Mrs.A Viji and the session came to an end with video presentation on motivational aspect of managing child with chorea.

Several videos were shown related to sub-topics of chorea gravidarum, in between and at the end of the each presentation., Participants were encouraged to participate in the discussion and Queries of the faculties and students were cleared. At the end of the programme, Dr.S.Indira, and, Mrs. Jayanthi distributed the certificates to all the speakers.. Post-test was conducted to assess the effectiveness of CNE programme. MS . Revathi Asst .Professor, proposed a vote of thanks and the programme concluded with the national anthem.

The result showed that, among 38 participants, in pre-test, 3(8%) had A Grade ,8(21%) had B+ Grade ,7(18%) had B Grade ,8(21%) had C Grade,12(32%) had D Grade knowledge. whereas in post-test,24(63%) had A+ Grade, 7(18.5%) had A Grade ,7(18.5%) had B+ Grade ,and 0% in B,C,D consecutively. Hence, it was concluded that, **CNE on “CHOREAGRAVIDARUM”** was effective in improving the participant’s level of knowledge.



The result showed that, among 38 participants, in pre-test, 0(0%) had A+ Grade ,3(8%) had A Grade ,8(21%) had B+ Grade ,7(18%) had B Grade ,8(21%) had C Grade,12(32%) had D Grade knowledge followed by In post-test,24(63%) had A+ Grade ,7(18.5%) had A Grade ,7(18.5%) had B+ Grade ,0(0%) had B Grade ,0(0%) had C Grade,0(0%) them had D Grade knowledge regarding Chorea gravid arum. Hence, it can be concluded that, the CNE programme on **Choreagravidarum** was effective in improving the participant’s level of knowledge.

CONCLUSION: The programme concluded that there was significant improvement of knowledge in post test as compared to the pre test. More participants had A+ grade than pre-test. **chorea gravidarun was considered as very effective method of teaching for improving knowledge among participants and can be recommended to apply in all areas of teaching along with regular class room teaching.**

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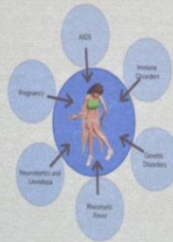
