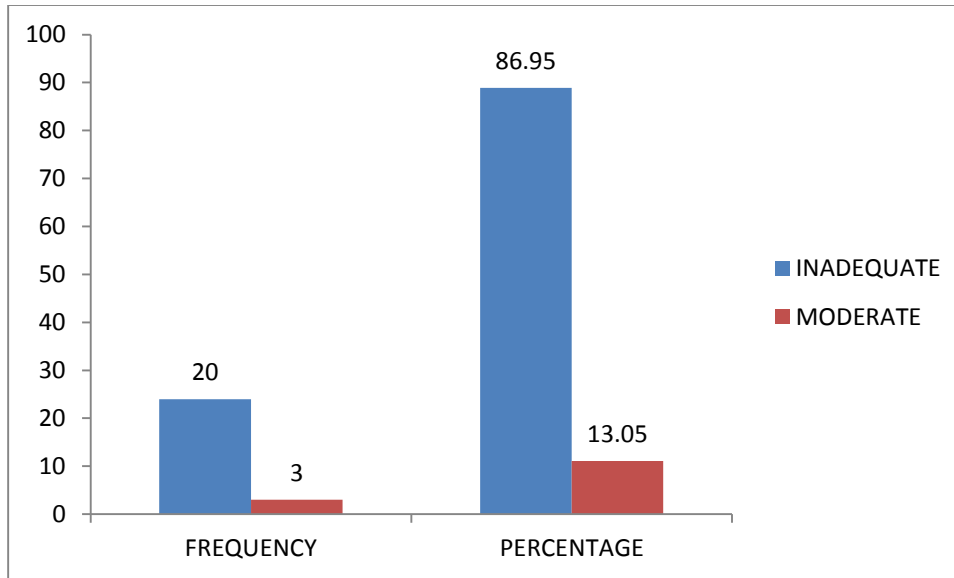


FIG: 1 frequency and percentage distribution of knowledge in pretest

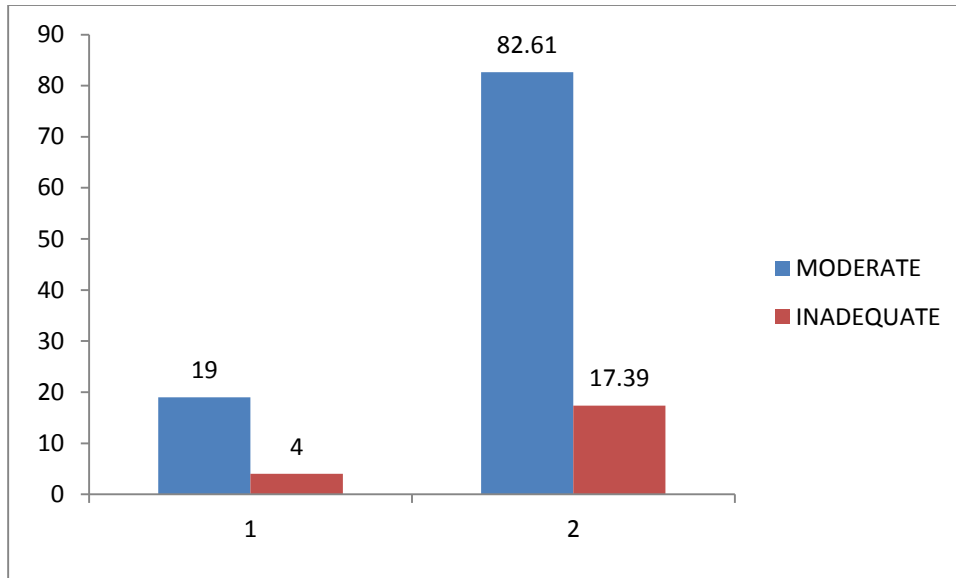


FIG: 2 frequency and percentage distribution of knowledge in posttest
