ANDHRA PRADESH BILLS
ANDHRA PRADESH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

The following Bill was introduced in the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly on 2nd December, 2017.

L. A. BILL No. 33 of 2017

A BILL TO PROVIDE FOR RESERVATION OF SEATS IN EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN THE STATE OF ANDHRA PRADESH AND OF APPOINTMENTS OR POSTS IN THE SERVICES UNDER THE STATE FOR THE TELAGA, KAPU, ONTARI AND BALIJA COMMUNITIES AND FOR MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH OR INCIDENTAL THERETO.

Whereas, the policy of reservation for the social, economic and educational upliftment of the citizens not only for the admissions into educational institutions but also for appointments in the services under the State is being implemented in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a long time and the same was being implemented for the Backward Classes, Schedule Castes and Schedule Tribes;

And Whereas, Article 15(4) of the Constitution of India empowers the State to make provisions for the Social and Educational Advancement of the Backward Classes;

And Whereas, Article 15(5) of the Constitution of India empowers the State to make any special provision by law for the advancement of any socially and educationally Backward Classes of citizens or for the Schedule Castes or Schedule Tribes in so far as such special provisions relate to their admission to educational institutions including private educational institutions either aided or unaided by the State other than the Minority Educational Institutions referred to in Clause (1) of Article 30;

And Whereas, Article 16(4) of the Constitution of India empowers the State to make any provision for the reservation of appointments or posts in favour of any Backward Class of citizens, which in the opinion of the State is not adequately represented in the services under the State;

And Whereas, Article 31 (C) of the Constitution of India Notwithstanding anything contained in Article 13, no law giving effect to the policy of the State towards securing allorany of the principles laid down in Part IV shall be deemed to be void on the ground that it is inconsistent with, or takes away or abridges any of the rights conferred by Article 14 or Article 19 and no law containing a declaration that it is for giving effect to such policy shall be called in question in any court on the ground that it does not give effect to such policy: Provided that where such law is made by the Legislature of a State, the provisions of this Article shall not apply thereto unless such law, having been reserved for the consideration of the President, has received his assent.

And Whereas, under Clause (1) of Article 38 of the Constitution of India, the State shall strive to promote the welfare of the people by securing and protecting as affectively as it may a social order in which justice, social, economic and political, shall inform all the institutions of national life;

And Whereas, under Clause (2) of Article 38 of the Constitution of India, the State shall, in particular, strive to minimize the inequalities in income, and Endeavour to eliminate inequalities in status, facilities and opportunities, not only amongst individuals but also amongst groups of people residing in different areas or engaged in different vocations;

And Whereas, under Clause (b) of Article 39 of the Constitution of India, the State shall, in particular, direct its policy towards securing that the ownership and control of the material resources of the community are so distributed as best to subserve the common good;

And Whereas, under Clause (c) of Article 39 of the Constitution of India, the State shall, in particular, direct its policy towards securing that the operation of the economic system does not result in the concentration of wealth and means of production to the common detriment;

And Whereas, the State Government after having careful consideration of the long standing demand of Kapus for inclusion in the Backward Classes category for reservations in admissions and appointments, keeping in view the social, economic, educational backwardness and inadequate representation in government services in proportion to their population, basing on the Report of the Commission, the State Government came to a conclusion that there is every need for inclusion of Kapus into the

Backward Classes category for reservation in admissions to educational institutions in the State and in the services under the State without there being any political reservation for their upliftment and to ensure their advancement in the State of Andhra Pradesh.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Sixty eighth year of the Republic of India as follows: -

1. (1) This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Kapu (Reservation of Seats in educational institutions and of appointments or posts in the services under the State) Act, 2017.

Short Title,
Extent and
Commencement:

(2) It extends to the entire State of Andhra Pradesh.

(3) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, appoint.

2. It is hereby declared that this Act is to give effect to the policy of the State to secure the principles laid down in Part-IV and in particular, Article 38 Clauses (1) and (2) and Article 39 Clauses (b) and (c) of the Constitution of India.

Declaration:

3. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires:-

Definitions:

(1) "Kapu" means the people belonging to the Telaga, Kapu, Ontari, Baliija communities of the State of Andhra Pradesh.

(2) "Backward Classes of people" means the class or classes of people who are socially and educationally backward, as may be notified by the Government in the Andhra Pradesh State Gazette from time to time.

(3) "Educational Institutions" mean

(i) any college or other educational institution maintained by the State or receiving aid out of the State funds or affiliated to any university established by law including an university college and a constituent college, or

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

For a country that has scarce and limited public resources, reservations unquestionably have important social, economic and political implications. The system of reservation in India comprises a series of affirmative action measures, such as reserving access to seats in the various legislatures, to government jobs, and to enrollment in higher educational institutions. The societal inequality in India is represented by the grossly inadequate representation of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Castes in employment and education due to historic, societal and cultural reasons. At the same time it is incumbent on the part of the state to ensure that equality prevails in all sections of the society. The primary objective of the present-day reservation system is to enhance the social and educational status of underprivileged communities and thus improve their lives. The term 'backward classes', as originally used around 1919, referred to a section of population which was backward in a socio-economic sense. It did not limit itself to the matrix of caste. The Constitution gives great liberties to the individual states to determine the quantity and limits of reservation. Reservation in common terms refers to an act of reserving, keeping back or withholding. Reservation in India is a form of affirmative action whereby a percentage of seats are reserved in the public sector units, union and state civil services, union and state government departments and in all public and private educational institutions, except in the religious/ linguistic minority educational institutions, for the socially and educationally backward communities and the Scheduled Castes and Tribes who are inadequately represented in these services and institutions. The underlying theory for the provision of reservation by the state is the under-representation of the identifiable groups.

The policy of reservation for the social, economic and educational upliftment of the citizens not only for the admissions into educational institutions but also for appointments in the services under the State is being implemented in the State of Andhra Pradesh for a long time and the same was being implemented for the Backward Classes, Schedule Castes and Schedule Tribes.

The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India by its Judgment in Indira Sawhney vs. Union of India reported in (AIR 1993 SC 477) observed that the reservations may cross/exceed the 50% limit in appointments or posts when there is a reasonable case for exceeding the limit and the same shall be substantiated with the existence of extraneous circumstances for such an act.

There were amendments to the Articles 15 and 16 of the Constitution by 81st Amendment Act, 2000 and 93rd Amendment Act, 2005 respectively and the same were challenged and the Supreme Court of India by its Judgments M. Nagaraj & others vs. Union of India & others reported in [(2006) 8 SCC 212] and

AshokaKumar Thakur vs. Union of India reported in [(2008) 6 SCC 1] laid down the law that if a State wants to exceed 50% of reservation then it is required to base its decision on the quantifiable data.

The British Government in Madras Presidency had recognized Kapus as backward caste in 1915 and the backward classes list of Andhra region included Kapus also. With the formation of the State of Andhra Pradesh on 1st October, 1953, a list of Backward Classes as existed in the Composite Madras State was adopted with slight modifications and the Kapus enjoyed reservations. In the wake of formation of the State of Andhra Pradesh, including the Telangana area as on 1st November, 1956, the list that

in which it is so laid or the session immediately following, both Houses agree in making any modification in the rule or in the annulment of the rule, the rule shall be with effect from the date of notification of such modification or annulment in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette is notified and have effect only in such modified form or shall stand annulled, as the case may be, so however, that any such modification or annulment shall be without prejudice to the validity of anything previously done under that rule.

Power to remove difficulties:

9. If there is any difficulty in giving effect to the provisions of this Act, the Government may, by an order published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette, make such provisions not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act as appear to them to be necessary or expedient for removing the difficulty;

Provided that no such order shall be made after the expiry of two years from the date of the commencement of this Act.

Explanation: For the purposes of this Act, "services under the State" includes the services under:-

- (i) State Government;
- (ii) State Legislature of Andhra Pradesh;
- (iii) Any local authority;
- (iv) Any Corporation or Company, Entity, owned and controlled by the Government; or
- (v) Any authority in respect of which the State Legislature has the power to make laws.

6. This Act shall not be construed as giving reservation to the political positions or political posts for the Kapus as the same is confined to the reservation for admissions into educational institutions in the State and in the services under the State.

No reservation to the Political posts or positions:

7. Basing on the advice and recommendations made by the Andhra Pradesh State Backward Classes Commission, the Government, may from time to time by notification, classify or sub-classify the Backward Classes people for the purposes of this Act.

Classification of Backward Classes people:

8. (1) The Government may make rules for the purposes of this Act.

Power to make Rules:

(2) (a) All rules made under this Act shall be published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette and shall come into force on the day on which they are so published unless it is expressly mentioned to come into force on a particular day.

(b) All notifications issued under this Act shall come into force on the day on which they are published, unless it is expressly mentioned to come into force on a particular day.

(3) Every rule made under this Act shall be laid before each House of the State Legislature, immediately, if it is in session and if it is not in session, in the next session which follows immediately for a total period of fourteen days which may be comprised in one session or in two successive sessions, and if, before the expiration of the session

- (ii) any institute or training centre recognized or approved by the Government with the object of preparing, training or guiding its students for any certificate, degree or diploma or other academic distinctions granted or conferred by any university or authority established or approved in this behalf by the Government.

(4) "Government" means the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

Reservation of

4. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any judgment, decree or order of any Court or other authority having regard to the social and educational backwardness of the Kapu people, the reservation in respect of the annual permitted strength in each branch or faculty for admission into educational institutions in the State for the Kapus shall be 5%.

(2) The reservation referred to in sub-section (1) shall, in respect of the persons belonging to the Backward Classes including the Kapus, the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes, be as hereunder: -

5. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in any judgment, decree or order of any Court or other authority, having regard to the inadequate representation in the services, of the Kapu people in the State of Andhra Pradesh, the reservation for appointments or posts in the services under the State, for the Kapus shall be 5% (Five percent).

(2) The reservation referred to in sub-section (1) shall, in respect of the persons belonging to the Backward Classes including the Kapus, the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes, be as hereunder:-

existed with the State of Hyderabad was continued, thereby maintaining two lists, one for Andhra and the other for Telangana area. In 1956, the then Andhra Pradesh Government deleted Kapus from the backward classes list. Again, though the successive Government tried to recognize them as other backward classes through a Government Order, the High Court struck down the G.O. on technical grounds.

There was a long standing demand for the inclusion of Kapu sub castes i.e., Telaga, Kapu, Ontari and Baliya into the Backward Classes category. The State Government after having careful consideration of their long standing demand for inclusion in the Backward Classes category for reservations in admissions and appointments keeping in view the social, economic, educational backwardness and inadequate representation in government services in proportion to their population, basing on the expert advice rendered by the Andhra Pradesh State Backward Classes Commission, the State Government came to a conclusion that there is every need for inclusion of Kapus into the Backward Classes category for reservation in admissions to educational institutions in the State and in the services under the State without there being any political reservation, for their upliftment and to ensure their all round advancement in the State of Andhra Pradesh.

This bill seeks to give effect to the above decision.

MEMORANDUM UNDER DELEGATED LEGISLATION

Clauses 1(3) 7 and 8 of the bill authorizes the Government to issue notifications or rules to make in respect of matters specified therein and generally to carry out the purposes of the Act. All such rules so made or notifications issued which are intended to cover the matters mostly of procedural in nature are to be laid on the table of the legislature of the state and will be subject to any modifications made by the State Legislature. The above provisions of the bill regarding Delegated Legislation are thus of normal type and are mainly intended to cover matters of procedure.

- (ii) Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside -the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the State; (Annexure –III)
- (iii) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporation Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi Public Institution within the State; and
- (iv) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies Universities and educational institutions recognized by the Government or a University or Other competent authority and similar other quasi Government institutions within the State.

N.B.: Relevant certificates in original must be produced at the time of verification of certificates, in respect of residence. The certificate should be obtained from the Revenue authorities.

8. Reservation of seats for Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes.

- 8.1 Out of the available seats for admission by the University 15% for SCs and 6% for STs shall be reserved in each local area. If any seat reserved for the Scheduled Tribes is not filled-up they will be open to the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Vice-Versa.
- 8.2 If the candidates from Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes are not available these reserved seats shall be re-allotted to candidates of open competition on the basis of merit.
- 8.3 Candidates from the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes belonging to Andhra Pradesh which are specified in the list as per the Government orders will be considered against the reserved seats.

9. Reservation for BC Candidates:

29% of the seats available for admission by the University, for B.Sc., Nursing 4 years degree Course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Backward Classes and shall be allotted among the BC groups as follow:-

BC-A-7%, BC-B-10%, BC-C-1%, BC-D-7% and BC-E-4%* as per the G.O.Ms.No.1793, Education, dt.23.09.1970 and G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Classes Welfare(C2) dated. 07-07-07 and G.O.Ms.No.231, Health Medical and Family Welfare (E1) Dept, dated. 11-07-2009.

* Reservation under BC-E is subject to further orders from Government of A.P./High Court.

Only those Candidates who belongs to these castes of the States of Andhra Pradesh/ Telangana which are listed in the Government orders shall be considered under the respective categories.

If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Classes of a particular group are not available, the left-over seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them, the left-over seats shall be treated as Open Competition seats and shall be filled up with candidates of open competition on the basis of merit.

- 9.1 While calculating the number of seats in the Sub-categories if the total number of seats falls short of or exceeds 29% it shall be limited to 29% by adding or eliminating the candidates on the basis of merit in the sub-groups in which the fractions were rounded to nearest figure.

- 9.2 In working out percentage of reserved candidates under SC, ST and BC categories, a fraction less than 0.5 will be ignored and if the fraction is 0.5 or more, it will be counted as one, subject to sub regulation 8(1).

10. Certification of Caste:

- 10.1 Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Backward Class candidates shall in support of their claim, have to furnish a certificate obtained from Mee Seva in the prescribed form issued by the Concerned Authority. If the certificate is not in the prescribed form, candidates will not be considered for selection under the reserved quota.
- 10.2 The social status of the candidates who have applied for the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall be scrutinized in terms of G.O.Ms.No.58 SW (J) Dept, dated.12-5-97.

11. RESERVATION UNDER PH CATEGORY:

Out of the available seats for admission by the Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, 5% shall be reserved for the Physically Handicapped (PH) in each category of OC, SC, ST, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D and BC-E as per Government of India guidelines.

The candidate seeking the benefit of reservation should present him/herself before a Medical Board constituted. The candidate shall submit a PH certificate issued by a Medical Board, comprising of at least one Expert/Specialist from the specialty of Orthopedics of Medical Board and obtain a valid disability certificate from the Medical Board having been issued within three months prior to presenting his application for seeking admission in any medical course by claiming the benefit of reservation.

12. Categorization of seats & Fee Structure:

- A. As per G.O.Ms.No.330, HM&FW (K1) Department, dt.11-11-2011, in respect of the Government colleges 100% Nursing seats shall be Competent authority, will be filled by the University. In unaided Non-minority institution 60% of the total number of seats shall be filled as competent authority seats by the University and the remaining 40% seats shall be filled by the college as management seats.

1 (a).Tuition Fee:

For Govt. Colleges fee fixed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

In unaided Non-minority institutions is as per G.O.Ms.No.153, H.M & F.W (C2) Dept., dated.12-09-2017.

7 The following categories of candidates are eligible under 15% of the available seats, i.e., un-reserved, in terms of the Presidential order

- (i) All local candidates defined in the Presidential order,
- (ii) Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside -the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the State; (Annexure -III)
- (iii) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporation Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi Public Institution within the State; and
- (iv) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies Universities and educational institutions recognized by the Government or a University or Other competent authority and similar other quasi Government institutions within the State.

N.B.: Relevant certificates in original must be produced at the time of verification of certificates, in respect of residence. The certificate should be obtained from the Revenue authorities

8. Reservation of seats for Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes.

- 8.1 Out of the available seats for admission by the University 15% for SCs and 6% for STs shall be reserved in each local area. If any seat reserved for the Scheduled Tribes is not filled up they will be open to the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Vice-Versa.
- 8.2 If the candidates from Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes are not available these reserved seats shall be re-allotted to candidates of open competition on the basis of merit.
- 8.3 Candidates from the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes belonging to Andhra Pradesh which are specified in the list as per the Government orders will be considered against the reserved seats.

9. Reservation for BC Candidates:

29% of the seats available for admission by the University, for Post Basic B.Sc., Nursing 2 years degree Course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Backward Classes and shall be allotted among the five groups of Back Ward Classes as follow:-

BC-A-7%, BC-B-10%, BC-C-1%, BC-D-7% and BC-E-4% as per the G.O.Ms.No.1793, Education, dt.23.09.1970 and G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Classes Welfare (C2), dated. 07-07-2007 and G.O.Ms.No.231, Health Medical and Family Welfare (E1) Department, dated. 11-07-2009.

* Reservation under BC-E is subject to further orders from Government of A.P./High Court.

Only those Candidates who belongs to these castes of the States of Andhra Pradesh/ Telangana which are listed in the Government orders shall be considered under the respective categories.

If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Classes of a particular group are not available, the left over seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them, the left over seats shall be treated as Open Competition seats and shall be filled up with candidates of open competition on the basis of merit.

- 9.1 While calculating the number of seats in the Sub-categories if the total number of seats falls short of or exceeds 29% it shall be limited to 29% by adding or eliminating the candidates on the basis of merit in the sub-groups in which the fractions were rounded to nearest figure.
- 9.2 In working out percentage of reserved candidates under SC, ST and BC categories, a fraction less than 0.5 will be ignored and if the fraction is 0.5 or more, it will be counted as one, subject to sub regulation 8(1).

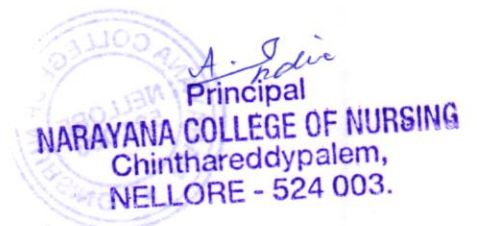

**PROSPECTUS FOR ADMISSION INTO M.Sc., (NURSING) COURSES AVAILABLE IN
THE COLLEGES LOCATED IN ANDHRA PRADESH STATE UNDER DR. NTRUHS
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22.**

REGULATIONS:

1. The following regulations shall apply for admissions into M.Sc., (Nursing) courses available in the Colleges in Andhra Pradesh for the academic year 2021-22.
2. **Number of Seats:** The number of colleges and seats for admission into first year M.Sc., (Nursing) courses for the academic year 2021-22 will be displayed prior to the counseling.

Note: a) In case any new Colleges/Courses are affiliated for starting the M.Sc., (Nursing) Courses for the academic year 2021-22, those seats will also be filled up. NO FURTHER NOTIFICATION WILL BE ISSUED.

- b) Some of the Colleges have given willingness to admit both male and Female candidates and the seats for male candidates will be allotted as per rules.
- c) The selections will be made to the above colleges subject to affiliation for the academic year 2021-22.
- d) As per G.O.Ms.No.338, HM & FW Dept., dated 16-08-2008, if sanctioned intake capacity is odd number, equal seats will go to management quota and Competent Authority Quota and odd seat will be rotated between the management quota and free quota year after year.
- e) The seat matrix will be displayed at the time of counseling.

3. ELIGIBILITY:

- 3.1 The Candidates should be Indian National and should satisfy Local or Non-Local status as per G.O.P. 646, Education Dept., dated 10-07-1979 and must satisfy the eligibility criteria as noted below:

S.No		Eligibility Status
a)	Age:	Both the Service and Non-service candidates should not have completed 45 years of age as on 31 st December of the year of admission. For candidates belonging to SC and ST's the maximum age limit shall be 48 years.
b)	Sex	Both women and men candidates are eligible to apply for the M.Sc (Nursing) as per GO .Ms. No. 77, HM & FW (K1) Dept, dated 13.06.2013. Regarding male candidate, admission will be as per G.O.Ms.No.79, HM & FW (K1) Dept, dated 17.06.2013.
c)	Educational Qualification	The candidate should have passed B.Sc., (Nursing) /B.Sc., Hons (Nursing)/Post Basic B.Sc., (Nursing) from an Institution which is recognized by the Indian Nursing Council with minimum of 55% aggregate marks and 5% relaxation of marks for SC and ST candidates.

5. Reservation of seats for Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes.

- 5.1 Out of the available seats for admission by the University 15% for SCs and 6% for STs shall be reserved in each local area. If any seat reserved for the Scheduled Tribes is not filled-up they will be open to the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Vice-Versa.
- 5.2 If the candidates from Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes are not available these reserved seats shall be re-allotted to candidates of open competition on the basis of merit.
- 5.3 Candidates from the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes belonging to Andhra Pradesh which are specified in the list as per the Government orders will be considered against the reserved seats.

6. Reservation for BC Candidates:

- i) 29% of the available seats for admission in each local area Under Dr. YSR UHS for **B.Sc(Nursing)** course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Backward Classes as follows:-

- ii) As per the G.O.Ms.No.1793, Education, dt.23.09.1970 and G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Classes Welfare (C2) dated. 07-07-07 and G.O.Ms.No.231, Health Medical and Family Welfare (E1) Dept, dated. 11-07-2009.

*Reservation under BC-E is subject to further orders from Government of A.P./High Court.

- 6.1 Only those Candidates who belongs to these castes of the States of Andhra Pradesh/ Telangana which are listed in the Government orders shall be considered under the respective categories.
- 6.2 If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Classes of a particular group are not available, the left-over seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them, the left-over seats shall be treated as Open Competition seats and shall be filled up with candidates of open competition on the basis of merit.
- 6.3 While calculating the number of seats in the Sub-categories if the total number of seats falls short of or exceeds 29% it shall be limited to 29% by adding or eliminating the candidates on the basis of merit in the sub-groups in which the fractions were rounded to nearest figure.
- 6.4 In working out percentage of reserved candidates under SC, ST and BC categories, a fraction less than 0.5 will be ignored and if the fraction is 0.5 or more, it will be counted as one, subject to sub regulation 8(1).

7. Certification of Caste:

- 7.1 Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Backward Class candidates shall in support of their claim, have to furnish latest **Integrated Caste Certificate with Barcode** obtained from Government of AP/Telangana in the prescribed form issued by the Concerned Authority. If the certificate is not in the prescribed form, candidates will not be considered for selection under the reserved quota.

7.2 The social status of the candidates who have applied for the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall be scrutinized in terms of G.O.Ms.No.58 SW (J) Dept, dated.12-5-97.

In case of Minority candidates, the Minority certificate issued by Minorities Welfare Department, Government of AP to be furnished in support of their claim.

8. RESERVATION UNDER PwD (Person with Disability) CATEGORY:

8.1 Out of the available seats for admission by the Dr. YSR University of Health Sciences, 5% shall be reserved for the Person with Disability (PwD) in each category of OC, SC, ST, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D and BC-E as per Government of India guidelines.

8.2 The candidate seeking the benefit of reservation should present him/herself before a Medical Board constituted by the University. Such candidates have to appear before the Medical Board, to be constituted by the Competent Authority and notified by the University for Eligibility under PwD status along with a valid disability certificate issued **not later than three months** prior to submitting his/her application. The report of the Medical Board is final for considering a candidate under PH quota as per rules.

9. Categorization of seats & Fee Structure:

9.1 As per G.O.Ms.No.330, HM&FW (K1) Department, dt.11-11-2011, in respect of the Government colleges 100% Nursing seats shall be Competent authority, will be filled by the University. In unaided Non-minority and Minority institution 60% of the total number of seats shall be filled as competent authority seats by the University and the remaining 40% seats shall be filled by the college as management seats.

9.2 FEE PARTICULARS:

9.2 (a).Tuition Fee:

- i) For Govt. Colleges fee - as fixed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.
- ii) In Private unaided Non-minority and Minority institutions - as fixed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

The counseling for admission will be made to the colleges affiliated for the year 2023-24 and fee as fixed by Govt. of AP shall be collected from the admitted candidates.

8. Reservation of seats for Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes.

- 8.1 Out of the available seats for admission by the University 15% for SCs and 6% for STs shall be reserved in each local area. If any seat reserved for the Scheduled Tribes is not filled-up they will be open to the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Vice-Versa.
- 8.2 If the candidates from Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes are not available these reserved seats shall be re-allotted to candidates of open competition on the basis of merit.
- 8.3 Candidates from the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes belonging to Andhra Pradesh which are specified in the list as per the Government orders will be considered against the reserved seats.

9. Reservation for BC Candidates:

- i) 29% of the available seats for admission in each local area Under Dr. YSR UHS for Post Basic B.Sc.,(Nursing) courses shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Backward Classes as follows:-

- ii) As per the G.O.Ms.No.1793, Education, dt.23.09.1970 and G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Classes Welfare(C2) dated. 07-07-07 and G.O.Ms.No.231, Health Medical and Family Welfare (E1) Dept, dated. 11-07-2009.

*Reservation under BC-E is subject to further orders from Government of A.P./High Court.

- 9.3 Only those Candidates who belongs to these castes of the States of Andhra Pradesh/ Telangana which are listed in the Government orders shall be considered under the respective categories.
- 9.4 While calculating the number of seats in the Sub-categories if the total number of seats falls short of or exceeds 29% it shall be limited to 29% by adding or eliminating the candidates on the basis of merit in the sub-groups in which the fractions were rounded to nearest figure.
- 9.5 In working out percentage of reserved candidates under SC, ST and BC categories, a fraction less than 0.5 will be ignored and if the fraction is 0.5 or more, it will be counted as one, subject to sub regulation 8(1).

10. Certification of Caste:

- 10.1 Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Backward Class candidates shall in support of their claim, have to furnish a certificate obtained from Government of AP/Telangana in the prescribed form issued by the Concerned Authority. If the certificate is not in the prescribed form, candidates will not be considered for selection under the reserved quota.
- 10.2 The social status of the candidates who have applied for the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall be scrutinized in terms of G.O.Ms.No.58 SW (J) Dept, dated.12-5-97.

11.RESERVATION UNDER PH CATEGORY:

11.1 Out of the available seats for admission by the Dr. YSRUniversity of Health Sciences, 5% shall be reserved for the Physically Handicapped (PH) in each category of OC, SC, ST, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D and BC-E as per Government of India guidelines.

11.2 The candidate seeking the benefit of reservation should present him/herself before a Medical Board constituted by the University. Such candidates have to appear before the Medical Board, to be constituted by the Competent Authority and notified by the University for Eligibility under PwD status along with a valid disability certificate issued **not later than three months** prior to submitting his/her application. The report of the Medical Board is final for considering a candidate under PH quota as per rules.

12.Categorization of seats& Fee Structure:

A. As per G.O.Ms.No.330, HM&FW (K1) Department, dt.11-11-2011, in respect of the Government colleges 100% Nursing seats shall be Competent authority, will be filled by the University. In unaided Non-minority institution 60% of the total number of seats shall be filled as competent authority seats by the University and the remaining 40% seats shall be filled by the college as management seats.

12.1. FEE PARTICULARS:

12.2 (a) Tuition Fee: For Govt. Colleges fee fixed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

12.2 (b) Tuition Fee: The Tuition fee in unaided private colleges is fixed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.

The counseling for admission will be made to the colleges affiliated for the year 2023-24 and fee as fixed by Govt. of AP

12.2 (c) University Fee: All the selected candidates shall pay the **non-refundable** fee i.e., **₹.5600/-** at the time of downloading of allotment order through online.

All the selected candidates have to pay the fee and other constituent fees and caution money deposits at the rates laid down for the purpose from time to time.
