7. Reservation of seats for Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes.

- 7.1 Out of the available seats for admission by the University 15% for SCs and 6% for STs shall be reserved in each local area. If any seat reserved for the Scheduled Tribes is not filled-up they will be open to the candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Vice-Versa.
- 7.2 If the candidates from Scheduled Castes & Scheduled Tribes are not available these reserved seats shall be re-allotted to candidates of open competition on the basis of merit.
- 7.3 Candidates from the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes belonging to Andhra Pradesh which are specified in the list as per the Government orders will be considered against the reserved seats.

8. Reservation for BC Candidates:

29% of the seats available for admission by the University, for B.Sc., Nursing 4 years degree Course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Backward Classes and shall be allotted among the BC groups as follow:-

BC-A-7%, BC-B-10%, BC-C-1%, BC-D-7% and BC-E-4%* as per the G.O.Ms.No.1793, Education, dt.23.09.1970 and G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Classes Welfare(C2) dated. 07-07-07 and G.O.Ms.No.231, Health Medical and Family Welfare (E1) Dept, dated. 11-07-2009.

*Reservation under BC-E is subject to further orders from Government of A.P./High Court.

Only those Candidates who belongs to these castes of the States of Andhra Pradesh/ Telangana which are listed in the Government orders shall be considered under the respective categories.

If qualified candidates belonging to Backward Classes of a particular group are not available, the left-over seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them, the left-over seats shall be treated as Open Competition seats and shall be filled up with candidates of open competition on the basis of merit.

- 8.1 While calculating the number of seats in the Sub-categories if the total number of seats falls short of or exceeds 29% it shall be limited to 29% by adding or eliminating the candidates on the basis of merit in the sub-groups in which the fractions were rounded to nearest figure.

9. Certification of Caste:

If the certificate is not in the prescribed form, candidates will not be considered for selection under the reserved quota.
- 9.2 The social status of the candidates who have applied for the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall be scrutinized in terms of G.O.Ms.No.58 SW (J) Dept, dated.12-5-97.

1. REGULATIONS:

The following are the regulations for admission of students into Post Basic B.Sc., Nursing 2YD Course in affiliated colleges of Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, A.P., for the Academic year 2021-22

- 2. They shall apply for the colleges affiliated to Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences.
- 3. The Post Basic B.Sc., Nursing Course is 2 years duration.
- 4. The list of affiliated colleges and number of seats available will be displayed Before exercising options for web counseling.

5. Eligibility:

5.1. The candidates should be of Indian Nationality or persons of Indian origin (P.I.O) / Overseas citizen of India (OCI) card holders and should satisfy the local or non-local status in Andhra Pradesh (Residence requirement) as laid down in Andhra Pradesh educational institutions (Regulations of admissions) order, 1974 and the selection will be done as per the procedure laid down in the G.O.P.No.646, dated 10-07-1979 as amended in G.O.Ms.No.42, Higher Education (EC2) Dept., dated 18-05-2009.

Male and female Candidates are eligible for admission into Post Basic B.Sc.,(N)2Years Course as per 228th EC resolution dated 05.05.2019.

5.2 Education Qualifications:

Candidates seeking admission into Post Basic B.Sc., (Nursing) Course should have passed Intermediate Examination.

OR

Any other equivalent examination (10+2 pattern) recognized by the University in A.P. or Board of Intermediate Education Andhra Pradesh or NIOS or APOSS – Indian Nursing Council Regulations.

AND

Should have passed **General Nursing and Midwifery** from an institution recognized by the Govt. of A.P. or Nursing Council of India and shall be registered with the State Nursing Council.

<u>NOTE</u>: The Candidates who studied 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ year MPHW are not eligible for admission into Post Basic B.Sc (N) 2YDC.

5.3 Government Service Candidates: Should have completed 2 years of service as a staff nurse in Medical and Health Department and Andhra Pradesh Vaidya Vidhana Parishad as on 28.02.2022. Service certificate as a staff nurse issued by the respective employer should be enclosed. Must be a Regular employee. Service certificate and regularization orders as staff nurse should be uploaded. Temporary / contract employees are not eligible

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- **5.4** Age: Candidate should have completed 21 years of age and should not be more than 45 years of age as on **31**st **December, 2021** In case of SC / ST Candidates the maximum age shall be relaxed by 3 years.
- Note: 1. Candidates born on or after 02-01-2001 are not eligible as they do not complete 21 years of age
 - 2. Candidates born on or before **31-12-1976** are not eligible as they are over aged and in case of SC/ST candidates born on or before **31-12-1973** are not eligible.
 - 3. A person born on 1st January of a year will complete one year on 31st December of the same year.
 - 4. Age shall be calculated on the basis of date of birth as indicated in the Secondary school Certificate examination or equivalent examination.

- 7.3.2 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Adilabad, Hyderabad, Rangareddy, Karimnagar, Khammam, Mahaboobnagar, Medak, Nalgonda, Nizamabad and Warangal shall be regarded as local area for the purposes of admission to the Osmania University, ** (the Kakatiya University) and to any other educational institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.
- 7.3.3 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Ananthapur, Kadapa, Kurnool, Chittoor and Nellore (Sri Venkateswara University) shall be regarded as local area for the purposes of admission to Sri Venkateswara University and to any other educational institution (other than a State-wide University or State-wide Educational Institution) which is subject to the control of the State Government and is situated in that part.

7.4 LOCAL CANDIDATES:

- 7.4.1 A Candidate for admission shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a local area.
 - i) If he/she has studied in an Educational Institution or Educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.

ii) Where during the whole or any part of the four consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in Educational Institution(s), if he/she had resided in that local area for a period of not less than 4 years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination, in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared.

(or)

iii) Local Status Certificate issued by MRO for claiming as AP local as per Circular Nos. 4136/SPF&MC/2015-5, dated.08.08.2016, 4136/SPF&MC/2015-13, dated. 20.11.2017 & G.O.Ms.No.129, dt: 28-10-2019 of General Administration Dept. Candidates Migrated from Telangana to Andhra Pradesh after bifurcation of state.

- 7.4.2 A candidate who is not regarded as a local candidate under subregulation (7.4.1) above in relation to any local area shall.
 - i) If he/she has studied in educational institutions in the State for a period of not less than 7 consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as local candidate in relation to:
 - Such local area where he/she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.
 - b) Where the period of his/her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has last studied in such equal periods.

(or)

- ii) If during the whole or any part of the seven consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for relevant qualifying examination, he/she has not studied in the educational institution in any local area, but he/she has resided in the State during the whole of the said period of 7 years be regarded as a local candidate in relation to
 - Such local area where he/she has resided for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years. (or)
 - b) Where the period of his/her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has resided last in such equal periods.


- b) Some of the Colleges have given willingness to admit both male and Female candidates and the seats for male candidates will be allotted as per rules.
- c) The selections will be made to the above colleges subject to affiliation for the academic year 2021-22.
- d) As per G.O.Ms.No.338, HM & FW Dept., dated16-08-2008, if sanctioned intake capacity is odd number, equal seats will go to management quota and Competent Authority Quota and odd seat will be rotated between the management quota and free quota year after year.

4. SERVICE QUOTA:

As per the G O. M S. No. 156, dated. 08.12.2016 of HM & FW (E), Dept., Govt. of AP, Velagapudi, Andhra Pradesh, 40% of seats out of total number of seats available at Sri Padmavathamma Government College of Nursing, Tirupati, and 40% of seats available at Govt. College of Nursing, Kurnool as per G.O.M.S No.86, dt. 07.08.2019 will be allotted for service candidates.

- 4.1 The quota for in-service Nursing Personnel admitted to M.Sc., (N) course in Sri Padmavathamma Government College of Nursing, Tirupati, Government College of Nursing, Kurnool and Govt. College of Nursing, Guntur shall be allowed up to 40% and the period of their study shall be treated as "Deputation". The selected candidates should submit orders of deputation from their respective state Government.
- 4.2 The period of required service in the Government for making application to the M.Sc., (Nursing) course is (5) years.
- 4.3 In the event of leaving the studies during the course period (or) in case of failure to serve the Government for (5) years after completion of the M.Sc., (Nursing) course, the individual has to pay an amount of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakhs only) besides refund of the amount received as salary up-to the date, to the Government.

5. RESERVATIONS:

Reservation for Scheduled Castes (S.C.) and Scheduled Tribes (S.T.):

- A) Out of the seats available for admission by the University, 15% seats shall be reserved for candidates belonging to SC, 6% of seats shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes in each local area.
 - i) In the event that if any seats reserved for S.T. not being filled up, they will be open to the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and vice-versa.
 - ii) In the event of the candidates from the SC and ST are not being available, these seats shall be allotted to the candidates under open competition.
 - iii) Candidates of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes belonging to the State of Andhra Pradesh only which are specified by the Govt. of A.P from time to time shall be considered

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B) RESERVATION FOR BACKWARD CLASSES:

29% of the available seats for admission in each local area by the University for shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Backward Classes as follows:

BC-A -7%, BC-B-10%, BC-C-1%, BC-D-7% & BC-E*-4% (* Subject to further orders of the Government of A.P. / High Court).

If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Class of particular group are not available, the leftover seats can be adjusted for the candidates of next group. If qualified candidates belonging to Back Ward Classes are not available to fill up the 29% seats reserved for them, the left-over seats shall be treated as Open Competition seats and shall be filled up with candidates by merit.

5.2. SOCIAL STATUS CERTIFICATE:

The candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes shall furnish a certificate in the prescribed proforma in support of their claims. The social status of Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Backward Classes candidates shall be Scrutinized in terms of G.O.M.s.No.58, SW (J) Dept. Dt. 12-05-1997.

The candidates are informed that they will not be considered for the caste claimed by them unless they upload the latest <u>Integrated Community Certificate</u>, prescribed by the Government and issued by the Revenue Authorities (Vide G.O.Ms.No.58, Social Welfare (J) Department, dated. 12-05-1997) with barcode. (Annexure-II)

Note :- The Social Reservation provided for BC's SCs, ST's in the ratio of 29%,15% and 6% respectively shall be vertical reservation.

5.2.(I) RESERVATION UNDER PWD CATAGORY:

Out of the available seats for admission, 5% shall be reserved for the Physically Handicapped (PwD) in each category of OC, SC, ST, BC-A, BC-B, BC-C, BC-D and BC-E as per Government of India guidelines.

The candidate seeking the benefit of reservation should present him/herself before a Medical Board to be constituted by Dr. NTR UHS. The candidate shall submit a PwD certificate issued by a Medical Board, comprising of at least one Expert/Specialist from the specialty of Orthopedics of Medical Board and obtain a valid disability certificate from the Medical Board having been issued within three months prior to presenting his application for seeking admission in any medical course by claiming the benefit of reservation.

5.3 RESERVATION IN FAVOUR OF THE LOCAL CANDIDATES:

5.3.1 Admission to 85% of Non-Statewide seats in each course of study shall be reserved in favour of the local candidates in relation to the local area. While determining 85% in favour of local candidate any fraction of a seat shall be counted as one as per the presidential order. The procedure as provided in A.P. Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission) Order, 1974 as amended from time to time and the procedure indicated in Annexure-III of G.O.P. No.646 Education, dated 10-07-1979 as amended shall be followed in selecting the candidates. The remaining 15% Seats are unreserved seats.

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5.4 LOCAL AREA:

- 5.4.1 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam, East Godavari, West Godavari, Krishna, Guntur and Prakasam shall be regarded as local area in respect of the Andhra University and Nagarjuna University area for the purpose of admission.
- 5.4.2 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Adilabad, Hyderabad(including twincities) Rangareddy, Karimnagar, Khammam, Medak, Mahaboobnagar, Nalgonda, Nizamabad and Warangal shall be regarded as local area in respect of Osmania University and Kakatiya University area for the purpose of admission.
- 5.4.3 The part of the State comprising the Districts of Ananthapur, Kurnool, Chittoor, Kadapa and Nellore shall be regarded as local area in respect of S.V. University/S.K. University area for the purpose of admission.
- 5.4.4 Local status certificate issued by MRO for claiming as AP local as per Circular Nos. 4136/SPF&MC/2015-5, dated.08.08.2016 and 4136/SPF&MC/2015-13, dt.20.11.2017

5.5 LOCAL CANDIDATES:

- 5.5.1 A Candidate for admission shall be regarded as local candidate in relation to a Local area
 - i) If he/she studied in an Educational Institution or Educational Institutions in such local area for a period of not less than 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which she appeared or as the case may be first appeared in relevant qualifying examination.

or

- ii) Where during the whole or any part of the 4 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination, she has not studied in Educational Institutions, if she had resided in that local area for a period of not less than 4 years immediately preceding the date of commencement of the relevant qualifying examination, in which she appeared or as the case may be first appeared.
- 5.5.2. A candidate for admission to any course of study who is not regarded as a local candidate under sub-regulation 5.5.1 above in relation to any local area shall
 - i) If he/she has studied in educational institutions in the State for a period of not less than 7
 consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which she appeared or as the
 case may be first appeared for the relevant qualifying examination be regarded as local
 candidate in relation to;
 - a) Such local area where she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.
 - b) Where the period of her study in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has last studied in such equal periods

or

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- ii) If during the whole or any part of the seven consecutive academic years ending with academic year in which she appeared or as the case may be first appeared for relevant qualifying examination, she has not studied in the educational institution in any local area, but she has resided in the state during the whole of the said period of 7 years be regarded as a local candidate in relation to
- a) Such local area where he/she has studied for the maximum period out of the said period of 7 years.

or

b) Where the period of his/her residence in two or more local areas are equal, such local area where he/she has resided last in such equal periods.

EXPLANATION: (for purpose of this sub-regulation)

- i) "Educational Institution" means a University or any Educational Institution recognized by the State Government, a University or any other competent authority.
- ii) "Relevant qualifying examination in relation to admission to any course of study" means the examination, a pass in which is the minimum educational qualification for admission to such course of study.
- NOTE: The relevant qualifying examination for admission to M.Sc., (Nursing) courses is B.Sc., (Nursing) examination. The question whether the candidate is a local candidate or not will be determined with reference to her first appearance in the Final B.Sc., (Nursing) examination.
- iii) In reckoning the consecutive academic year during which a candidate has studied any period of interruption of his/her study by reasons of his/her failure to pass any examination and any period of his/her study in a statewide University or a statewide educational institution shall be disregarded.
- iv) The question whether any candidate for admission to any course of study has resided in any local area shall be determined with reference to the places where the candidate actually resided and not with reference to the residence of his/her parent or guardian.
- **5.6** While determining under sub-regulation 5.3.1 the number of seats to be reserved in favour of local candidates, any fraction of seat shall be counted as one, provided that there shall be one unreserved seat.
- 5.7 If a local candidate in respect of a local area is not available to fill any seats reserved or allocated in favour of local candidate in respect of that local area such seats shall be filled in as if it had not been reserved.

Those who did not qualify as local candidate under sub-regulation 5.5.1 (i) or 5.5.2 (i) but claim to qualify by virtue of residence shall produce a certificate issued by an officer of the Revenue Department not below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer independent charge of subtaluk/Mandal in the form annexed to G.O.P.No.628, Education, dated 25-7-1974 appended as Annexure – I



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- 5.8 The applicant who claims to be local candidate with reference to sub-regulation 5.5.1 (i) or 5.5.2 (i) shall produce in the form of study certificate/certificates issued by the Head of the Educational Institution / Institutions concerned indicating the details of the year or years in which the candidate has studied in educational institution in such local area for a period of not less than 4/7 consecutive academic years ending with the academic year in which he/she appeared or as the case may be first
- 5.9 The following categories are eligible to apply for admission to the 15% of unreserved seats.
 - 5.9.1 All candidates defined under Regulation 5.5.
 - 5.9.2 Candidates who have resided in the state for total period of ten years excluding period of study outside the State, or either of those parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding period of employment outside the state.
 - 5.9.3 Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi - Public Institutions in the State.
 - 5.9.4 Candidates, who are spouses of those in employment of this State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Government or a University or other competent authority and similar other quasi Government institutions within the State.
 - 5.9.5 Candidates who are employed in the State Government undertakings, Public Sector corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi-Public institutions within the State.
 - 5.9.6 Candidates who are spouses of the local candidates as per Regulation 5.5.
 - **N.B.:** Relevant certificates must be attached to the application in respect of their claim, in respect of residence. The certificate should be obtained from the Revenue authorities not below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer/Tahsildar.

6. DURATION OF THE COURSE:

The duration of the course shall be two years.
