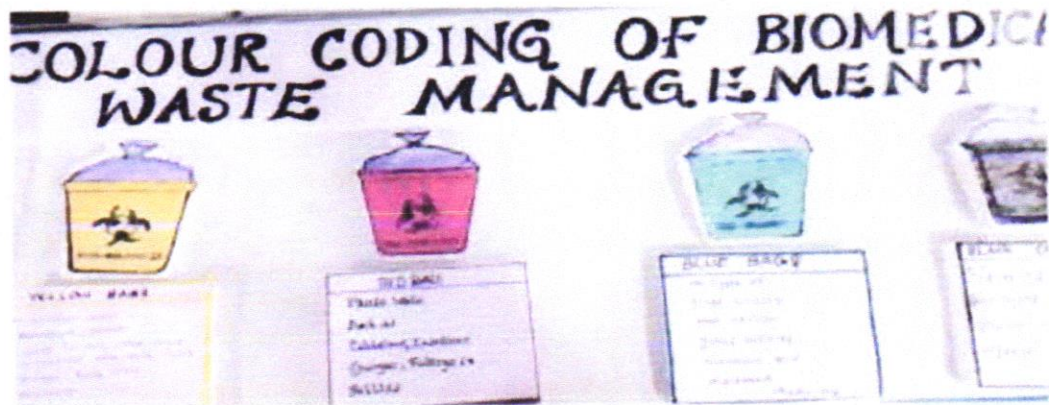


Fig1: Color coding of biomedical waste management in different colored bags
