








URBAN AREA MAPPING

INTRODUCTION:

The students of final year B.Sc Nursing students of Narayana College of Nursing, were posted to the Rural Health Center, Venkatachalam village, about 10 kms from the college for community health nursing field experience. The students were divided into 3 groups:

- 1. Survey group
- 2. Student activity group
- 3. Health center activity group.

General Description of the Community:

Genesis:

According to collected history, Venkatachalam is a Mandal in Spsr Nellore District of Andhra Pradesh State, India. Venkatachalam Mandal Head Quarters is Venkatachalam town. It belongs to Andhra region.

Family folder system is followed to ensure continuity of home care and documentation. Families are assessed and educated on appropriate health care and responsible family member is demonstrated on homecare of chronically ill clients. The nursing students are posted along with the staff and Nursing supervisors for Home visits, clinics and special programmes.









Language:

Telugu language is the mother tongue of all people of the village. Few of them English, urdu to speak.

Communication: the village has adequate means of communication like mobile phones, telephones, television, news paper, post office. The verbal means of communication in the village is telugu is about 90% and other languages like urdu and English 10%.

Transport: all most all the people of venkatacham are using RTC buses for transportation. Most of the time they are using private buses. Other form of transportation is train and their own vehicles like two wheelers and four wheelers.



Conclusion:


