Narayana hospital is having total bed strength of 1668 beds and is equipped with all the facilities for patient care and clinical-teaching learning over and above the norms suggested by the Statutory Council.

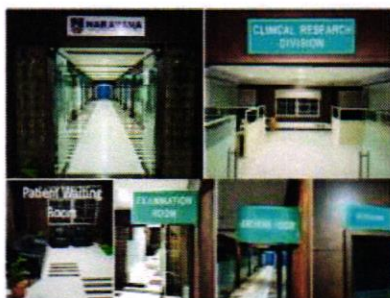
- A total of 25 Operation Theatres are available.
- Central Sterile Service Department is available to serve the sterile material.
- Medical, Surgical, Pediatric, Neonatal, Respiratory & Coronary care ICUs are well equipped with monitors, ventilators, defibrillators, central oxygen, suction, IABP and facility for dialysis inside ICU.
- The dialysis unit functions round the clock. Pharmacy is open round the clock.
- Hospital is well equipped with CT and MRI machines, Digital Subtraction Angiography lab, Mammography & Sonomammography machines, Cath Lab, Neuro EEG lab.
- Interventional radiological procedures some special procedures are carotid artery stenting, cerebral sinus thrombolysis, aneurysm clipping, cerebral & peripheral DSAs, CT guided biopsies. Postgraduate students assist in procedures & get trained under supervision.
- Fully equipped labs with 24 hours services like Flow cytometry, Chemiluminescence, Dry chemistry analyzer and BacT/Alert 3D 60 for blood culture.
- NABB accredited blood bank offers services round the clock. The blood bank also provides specialized services like therapeutic Plasma Exchange, Platelet pheresis. Clinical Skill and Simulation Labs are equipped with mannequins & simulators.

Narayana Translational Research Centre

NTRC (recognized by DSIR, Govt. of India) – is an advanced center established with a view to be at par with international standards in both pre-clinical and clinical research. The infrastructure of the facility is of world class with a built in area of 16,000 Sq.Ft. which includes – Clinical Research Division, Conference Room, four Biosafety level II clean rooms with laminar air flow type II- A in each room to carry out Stem Cell, Molecular biology and Genetic studies. A central Laboratory exists with state of art instruments such as Real- Time PCR, Ultra High Performance Liquid Chromatography (UHPLC), Flow Cytometer, Inverted Fluorescence Microscope, Nanodrop and Microbiology incubator and Laminar hood. As well equipped with necessary equipment's including cooling centrifuges, refrigerators and freezers (-20 & -80 deg. C), Gel-documentation system and an IR Camera. Outcome of various research activities carried out in this centre were published in both national and international reputed journals.

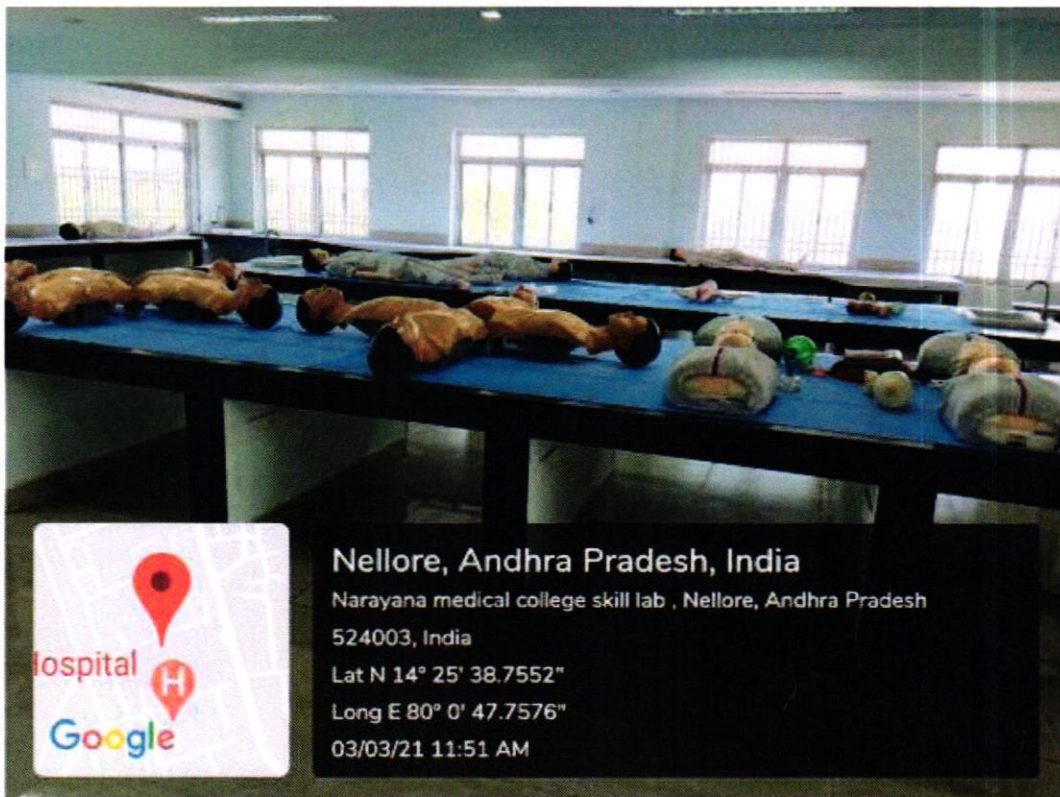
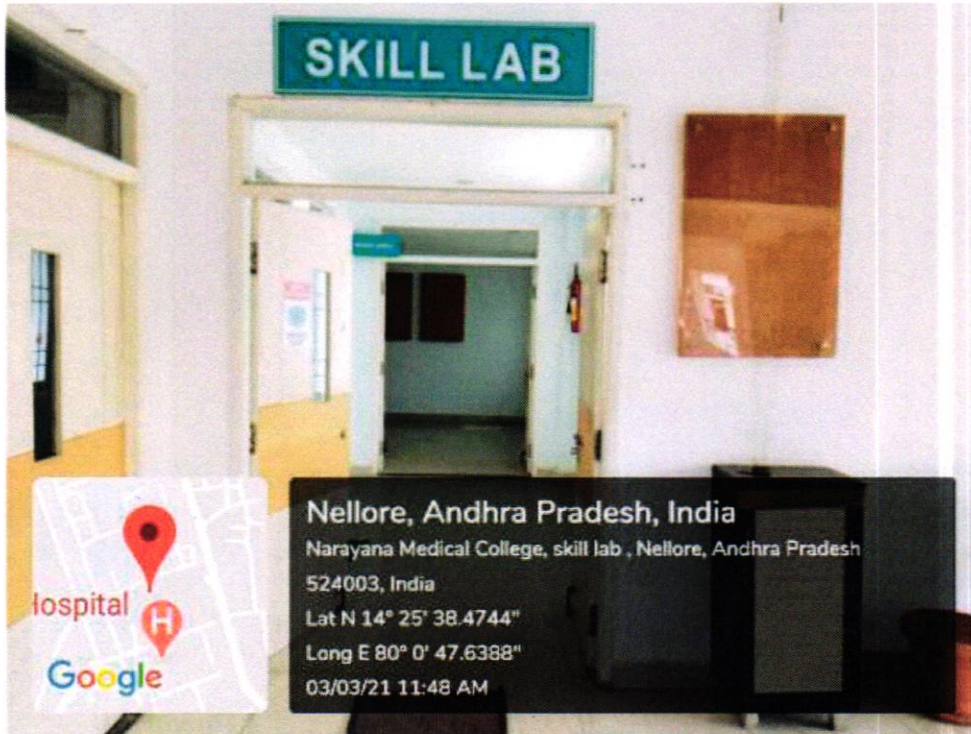
CENTRAL RESEARCH ANIMAL FACILITY

A two-storeyed Animal facility was established in 1999 and utilized for experimental research in accordance with the CPCSEA guidelines of the Government of India. It fully air –conditioned and houses lab animals such as rats, mice, rabbits and guinea pigs. It facilitates the following activities – UG and PG pharmacy animal practical experiments; in-house medical and paramedical research; inter-institutional research and industrial research. Animal health and well-being is monitored daily by a veterinarian; and animals were well maintained and fed ad libitum by animal care-takers (24 h x 7 d)

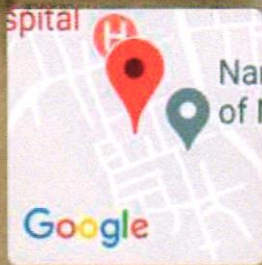
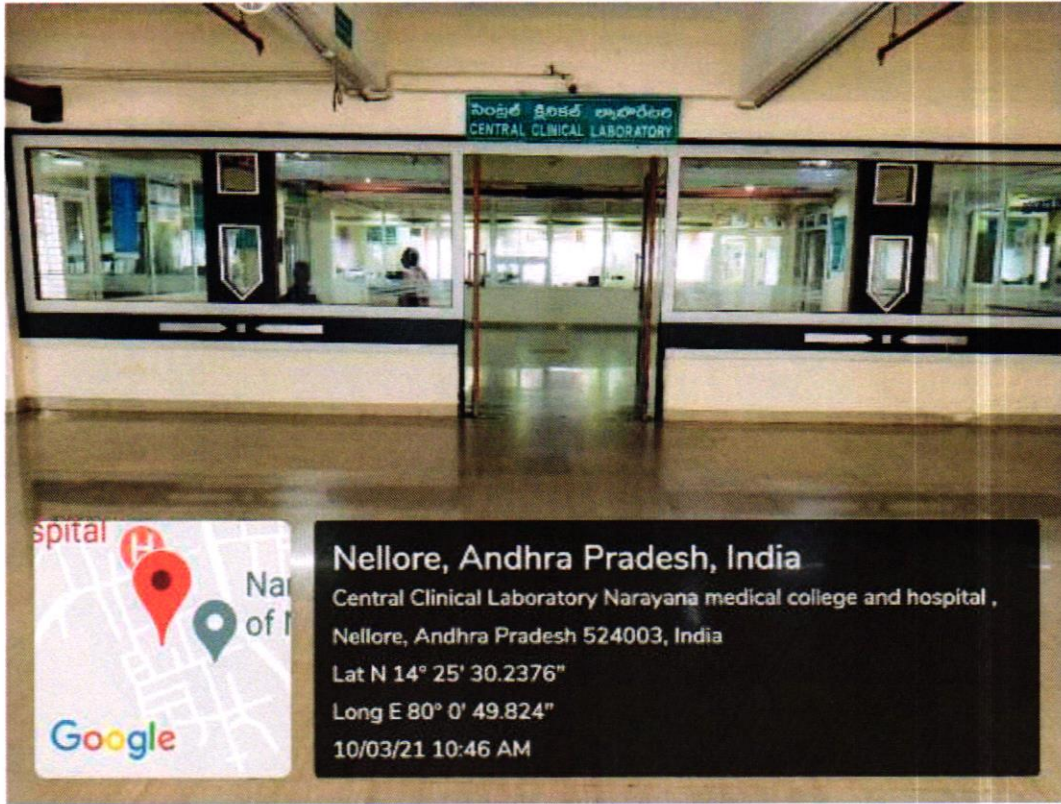

GUIDELINES AND MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS TO ESTABLISH B.Sc. (N) COLLEGE OF NURSING

1. The following Establishments/Organizations are eligible to establish/open a B.Sc. (Nursing) College of Nursing.
 - a) Central Government/State Government/Local Body;
 - b) Registered Private or Public Trust;
 - c) Organizations registered under Societies Registration Act including Missionary Organizations;
 - d) Companies incorporated under Section 8 of Company's Act.
2. The eligible Establishments/Organizations should have their own 100 bedded Parent Hospital. Provided that in respect of Tribal and Hilly Area the requirement of own Parent Hospital is exempted.
 - Tribal area – Scheduled Notified Area {Areas as the President of India may by order declare to be Scheduled Areas};
 - Hilly area – Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir, Union Territory of Ladakh, North East States, Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand.
3. The eligible Establishments/Organizations should obtain Essentiality Certificate/No Objection Certificate from the concerned State Government where the B.Sc. (Nursing) College of Nursing is sought to be established. The particulars of the name of the College/Nursing Institution along with the name of the Trust/Society [as mentioned in Trust Deed or Memorandum of Association] as also full address shall be mentioned in No Objection Certificate/Essentiality Certificate.
4. After receipt of the Essentiality Certificate/No Objection Certificate, the eligible institution shall get recognition from the concerned SNRC for the B.Sc. (Nursing) program for the particular Academic Year, which is a mandatory requirement.
5. The Indian Nursing Council shall after receipt of the above documents/proposal online would then conduct Statutory Inspection of the recognized training nursing institution under Section 13 of the Act in order to assess the suitability with regard to availability of Teaching Faculty, Clinical and Infrastructural Facilities in conformity with Regulations framed under the provisions of the Act.

*Provided that training institutions shall apply for statutory inspection, under Section 13 of the Act, to the Council within 6 months from obtaining recognition from the SNRC.

CLINICAL FACILITIES

CLINICAL FACILITIES for 60 students

1. Parent hospital

College of Nursing should have a 100 bedded Parent/Own Hospital.

2. Additional Affiliation of Hospital

In addition to Parent Hospital of 100 beds, institution shall take affiliation of the hospital, if all the required learning experience are not available in the parent hospital. As 100 beds is not sufficient to offer clinical experience/specialities to students as laid down in the B.Sc. (Nursing) syllabus. The students should be sent to affiliated hospital/agencies/institutions where it is available.

a. Criteria for Affiliation

The types of experience for which a nursing college can affiliate are:

- Community Health Nursing
- Mental Health (Psychiatric) Nursing
- Specialty like Cardiology, Neurology, Oncology Nephrology, Orthopaedics, communicable/ infectious disease etc.
- Obstetrics, Gynaecology, Paediatrics etc.

- Should not be less than 50 beds apart from having own hospital
- Bed occupancy of the hospital should be minimum 75%

- Communicable disease/Respiratory medicine/TB & chest diseases
- Dermatology
- Cardiology
- Oncology/Neurology/Neuro-surgery
- Nephrology
- ICU/ICCU
- Geriatric Medicine
- Any other specialty as per syllabus requirements

Note:

- i. Educational visits will also be conducted as per the B.Sc. (Nursing) syllabus (for example: Milk Treatment plant, Water and Sewage plant, Rehabilitation Centres, Orphanage, Geriatric Care, Home for Destitute, Professional Organisation etc.).
- ii. The Nursing Staffing norms in the Parent and Affiliated Hospital should be as per the Staff Inspection Unit (SIU) norms.

- iii. The Parent/affiliated Hospital should give student status to the candidates of the nursing program.
- iv. Maximum Distance between affiliated hospitals & institutions should not be more than 30 kms.
- v. For Hilly & Tribal the maximum distance can be 50 kms.
- vi. 1:3 student patient ratio to be maintained.
- vii. **Distribution of Beds:** At least one third of the total number of beds should be for medical patients and one third for surgical patients. The number of beds for male patients should not be less than $1/6^{\text{th}}$ of the total number of beds i.e. at least 40 beds. There should be minimum of 100 deliveries per month. Provision should be made for clinics in health and family welfare and for preventive medicine.

5. Community Health Nursing Field Practice Area

The students should be sent for community health nursing experience in urban as well as rural field area. The institution can be attached to primary health centre. A well set up field teaching centre should be provided with facilities for accommodation of at least 10-15 students and one staff member at a time. Peon, cook and chowkidar should be available at health centre. Each College of Nursing should have its own transport facility and it must be under the control of the principal. The security of staff and students should be ensured.

ANTI-RAGGING

Anti-ragging guidelines as per gazette notification shall be followed.

BUDGET

In the overall budget of the institution, there should be provision for college budget under a separate head. Principal of the College of Nursing should be the drawing and disbursing authority.

1. The following Establishments/Organizations are eligible to start a M.Sc. (Nursing) program.
 - a) Central Government/State Government/Local Body;
 - b) Registered Private or Public Trust;
 - c) Organizations registered under Societies Registration Act including Missionary Organizations;
 - d) Companies incorporated under Section 8 of Company's Act.
2. An institution offering B.Sc. (Nursing) program wherein one batch has passed out is eligible to start a M.Sc. (Nursing) program.

OR

Super specialty hospital having the following requisite beds is eligible to start a M.Sc. (Nursing) program.

Cardiothoracic Nursing

- 50-100 bedded Cardiac Hospital, which has CCU, ICCU and ICU units with own thoracic unit or affiliated thoracic unit.

Critical Care Nursing

- 250-500 bedded hospital, which has a 8-10 beds critical care beds and ICUs

OBG Nursing

- 50 bedded parent hospital having
 - Mother and neonatal units
 - Case load of minimum 500 deliveries per year
 - 8-10 level II neonatal beds.
 - Affiliation with level III neonatal beds

Neuro Science Nursing

- Minimum of 50 bedded Neuro care institution with advanced diagnostic, therapeutic and state of the art clinical facilities.

- 250-500 bedded Hospital, which has a 50 orthopedic beds & rehabilitation units.

Psychiatric Nursing

- Minimum of 50 bedded institutes of psychiatry and mental health having all types of patients (acute, chronic, adult psychiatric beds, child psychiatric beds and de-addiction facilities), with advanced diagnostic, therapeutic and state of the art clinical facilities.

Paediatric & Neonatal Nursing

- 250-500 beds and level II/III NICU facility, NICU beds: ≥ 10

Operation Room Nursing

- 250-500 bedded Hospital having facilities for General Surgery, Pediatric, Cardiothoracic, Gynaecology and Obstetrics, Orthopaedics, Ophthalmic, ENT and Neuro Surgery.

Emergency and Disaster Nursing

- 250-500 bedded Hospital with ICU facility and 10 Emergency beds.

(Nursing) program is sought to be established. The particulars of the name of the College/Nursing Institution along with the name of the Trust/Society [as mentioned in Trust Deed or Memorandum of Association] as also full address shall be mentioned in No Objection Certificate/Essentiality Certificate.
4. After receipt of the Essentiality Certificate/No Objection Certificate, the eligible institution shall get recognition from the concerned SNRC for the Post Basic B.Sc. (Nursing) program for the particular Academic Year, which is a mandatory requirement.

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PHYSICAL FACILITIES

College of Nursing, which are already running B.Sc. (Nursing) or G.N.M. program will require additional 2 (Two) Lecture Halls : 2@1080 = 2160 Sq. feet for P.B.B.Sc. (N) program for 40-60 Students intake.

Note: Proportionately the other facilities will increase according to the number of students admitted.

Note:- Minimum provision of hostel accommodation for 30% of the total student's intake is compulsory for the institution and accordingly the staff for hostel shall be provided as prescribed in the syllabi.

NURSING TEACHING FACULTY

The principal should be the administrative head of the College. He/She should hold qualifications as laid down by the Council. The principal should be the controlling authority for the budget of the College and also be the drawing and disbursing officer. The Principal and Vice-Principal should be gazetted officers in Government Colleges and of equal status (though non-Gazetted) in non-government Colleges.
