

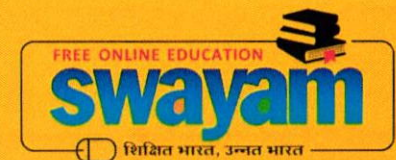

INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE EXAM

1. The Admit Card must be presented for verification along with one original photo identification (not photocopy or scanned copy). Printed copy of hall ticket and original photo ID card should be brought to the exam centre. Hall ticket and ID card copies on the phone will not be permitted.
2. This Admit Card is valid only if the candidate's photograph and signature images are legible. To ensure this, print the admit card on A4 sized paper using a laser printer, preferably a colour photo printer.
3. Please report to the examination venue by 08:00 am. CANDIDATES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO ENTER THE EXAM PREMISES AFTER 09.30am.
4. Candidates will be permitted to appear for the examination ONLY after their credentials are verified by center officials.
5. At 08:40 am – Candidates will be permitted to occupy their allotted seats. At 08:50 am – Candidates can login and start reading instructions prior to the examination.
6. Candidates are advised to locate the examination center at least a day prior to the examination, so that they can reach the center on time for the examination.
