Policy Statement:

g. Strengthen College's Reputation: Enhance the image and ethos of the college through the active involvement of students in professional and community activities.

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Guidelines:

a. All nursing students are encouraged to become active members of the SNA and participate in its activities.

b. A wide variety of events, including workshops, seminars, and community outreach, will be organized regularly for the benefit of students.

c. All activities will be planned with attention to Health and Safety guidelines to ensure the wellbeing of participants.

d. Student involvement in SNA activities will be recognized and celebrated through awards, certificates, and public acknowledgment.

e. SNA events and activities will be planned and communicated to students on a termly basis, allowing sufficient time for participation and preparation.

f. For activities that involve travel or off-campus participation, proper planning and adherence to the college's procedures for off-site events will be followed.

Steps to Ensure:
