
The institution respects the diverse culture of students and faculty. It aims at developing the strength of the Nation and makes everyone united to stand for the institution's mission and vision.







An invitation was given one Week prior to the celebration to all the HODs and faculty. Pencil Drawing Competition Was Conducted One Day before the program.








Fig:A garland was placed on the statue of Florence Nightingale by faculty and students.




Fig: Faculty and students given the Florence Nightingale pledge with the candles.






Fig 1: . NSS volenteers and parents of Narayana College of Nursing present in the webinar




Fig 2: Narayana college of Nursing Nss volenteers participating in the international yoga Day








Fig No 1: Dignitaries on the Dias




Fig No 3: Speech by Chief Guest Sr. Mariyamma, Vice Principal of St. Joseph Nursing College




Fig No 4: Speech by Dr.Indira.A Principal of Narayana College of Nursing




Fig No 1: Faculties and students are attended the program




Fig No 2: Mr. Rushi, CSO live demonstrating the fire safety measures




Fig No 3: Faculties and Students have group photo with security team




Fig No 2: Health Promotion team live demonstration on dietary menu to the athlete's parents.




Fig No 3: Nutritional education to the athlete's parents.




Fig No 4:Group photo with Red Cross Soceity Team Members








Fig No 5: Guinness World Records Certificate and Asia Book of Records




Fig No 6: Displayed Healthy fresh fruits and vegitables






Fig: Faculty were giving education regarding diabetic diet




Fig:Faculty were checking Blood pressure to the blood donors



Fig 1: Percentage Distribution of Level of Awareness Among Participants (N=51)











Fig 2: Dr Sham prasad Vice chancellor NTRUHS Vijayawada




7.1.10The Institution celebrates / organizes national and international commemorative days, events and festivals


