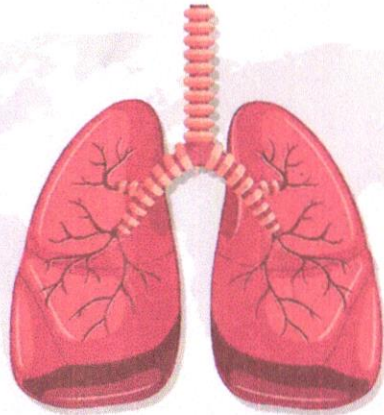

World TB Day is observed on March 24 each year to raise public awareness and understanding about one of the infectious diseases - Tuberculosis. As per the WHO report the incidence of TB in 2023 is 192/ 100000 population. The patients who are affected by TB will suffer physically, emotionally, socially and economically. There is a need for creating awareness among the general public and health care professionals on tuberculosis management and its prevention

In this regard, the Department of Community Health Nursing, in collaboration with the NSS unit, observed World Tuberculosis Day on March 24, 2023, in the Narayana College of Nursing, 2nd floor, Smart class room, with the theme "Yes, we can end TB." FIVE PRINCIPAL COMPONENTS OF DOTS

- Political and administrative commitment
- Case detection by sputum smear microscopy
- Uninterrupted supply of high-quality anti-TB drugs
- Standardized treatment regimens with directly observed treatment for at least the first two months
- Systematic monitoring and accountability
