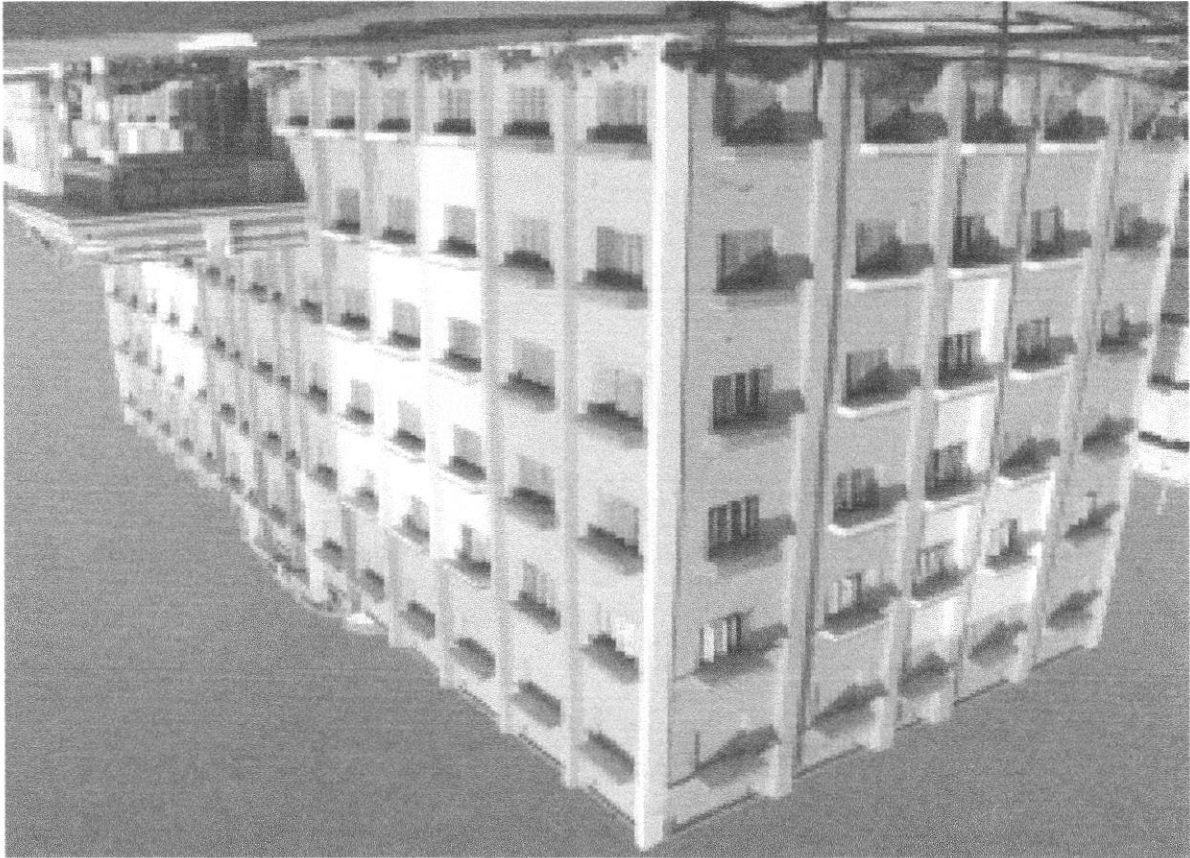

Every year, December 10 is marked as International Human Rights Day. It commemorates the adaptation of the universal declaration of human rights by the united national general assembly in 1948. Human rights are the inalienable rights that every human being is entitled to from birth, irrespective of race, caste, creed, gender, language, political or other belief or any other status. The theme of Human Rights Day this year is 'Dignity, Freedom, and Justice for All' as it marks the entry of UDHR into the 75th year of its existence as well as a year-long



campaign to promote and recognize it as the foundation for an expanding system of human rights protection for various sections of society amidst different challenges before humanity.

With this spirit, Narayana College of Nursing NSS unit had initiated to create awareness on this event. Dr. Indira A, Principal, Narayana college of Nursing, Dr.V. Kumari, Vice principal(Academic) , Prof. B. Vanaja Kumari, Vice principal , HOD of Community nursing, Prof. A. Latha IQAC co-coordinator, HOD of Medical surgical nursing and all other HODs and faculties were participated in the program. Program started at 12pm with a prayer song, continued with welcome song. The program followed by welcome address by Mrs. K.Madhavi Latha, NSS Program officer. Then the program was initiated with lamp lighting by the dignitaries. Pre test was conducted to the participants about Human rights day.

Dr. Indira. A , Principal, orientated about the need of human rights for every individual and explained about role of nurse in application of human rights related to patient care.

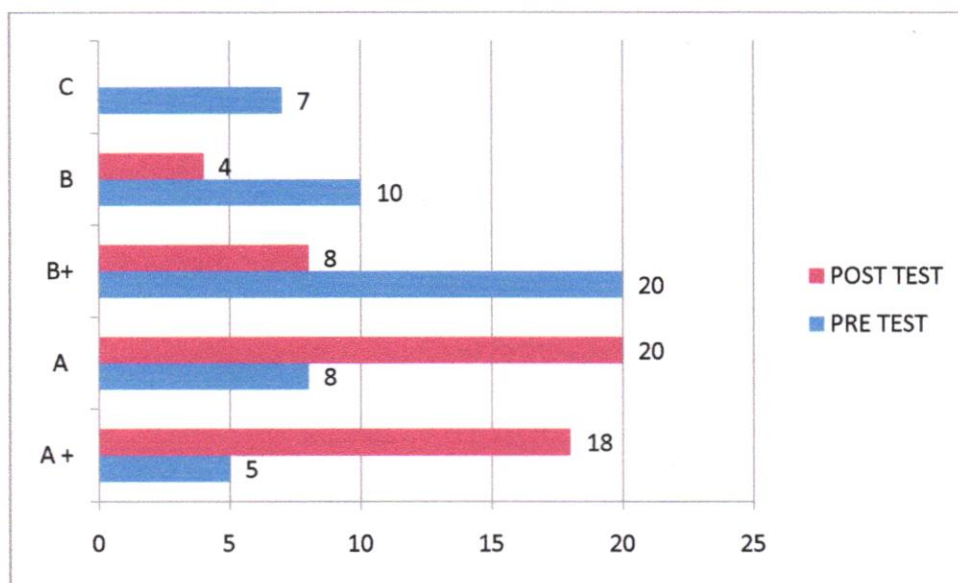
The program forwarded by Prof.Mrs.Vanaja Kumari, HOD of Community nursing. She explained about history of human rights, importance of human rights.

The pre test knowledge scores were, A+ grade 5 (10 %), A grade 8(16 %), B+ grade 20 (40 %), B grade 10 (20 %), C grade 7 (14 %). Whereas in the post test the knowledge level scores were improved as A+ grade 18 (36 %), A grade 20 (40 %), B+ grade 8 (16 %), B grade 4 (8 %) and there was no participants in C grade. This result reveals that international human rights day program was effective.

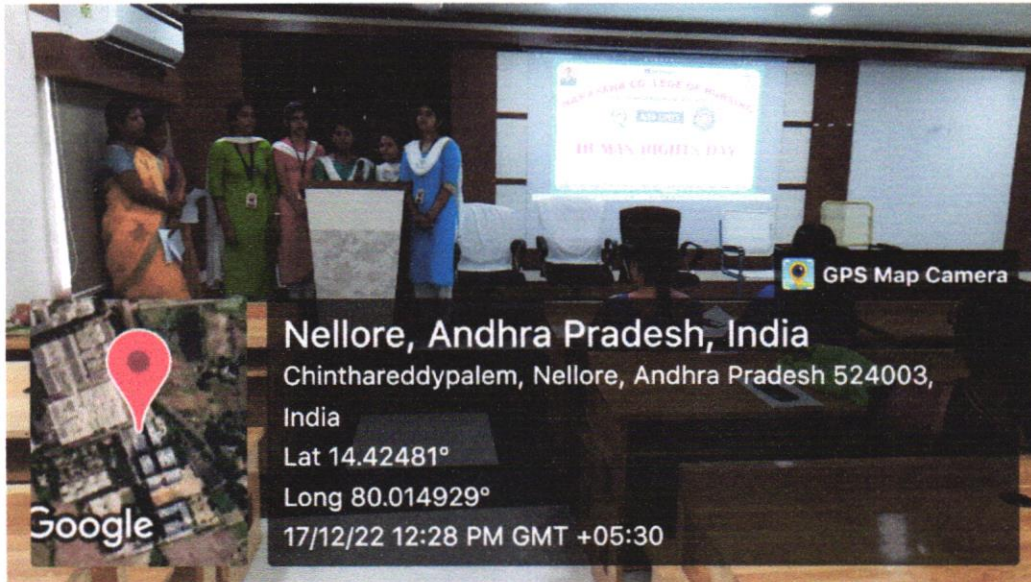


Fig 1: The students are singing prayer song

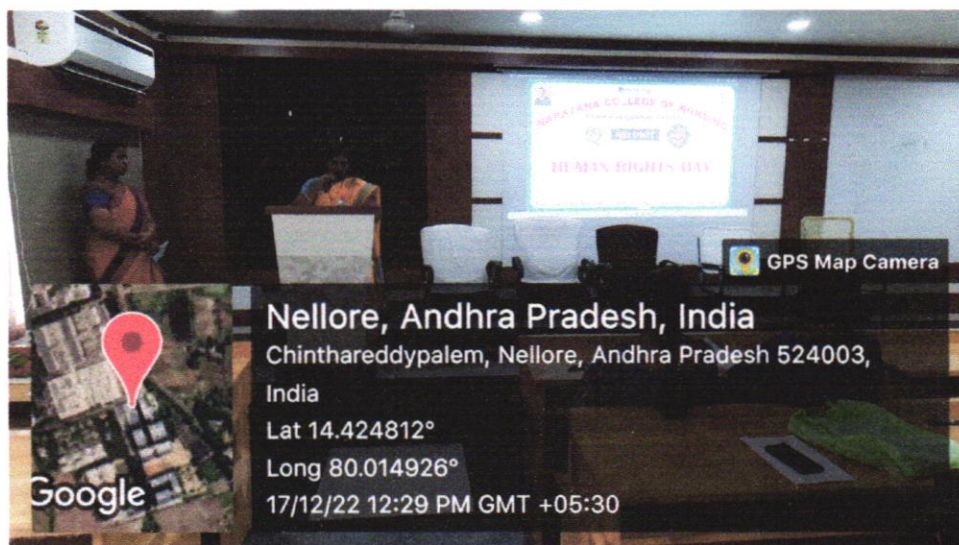


Fig 2: NSS Program officer giving welcome address

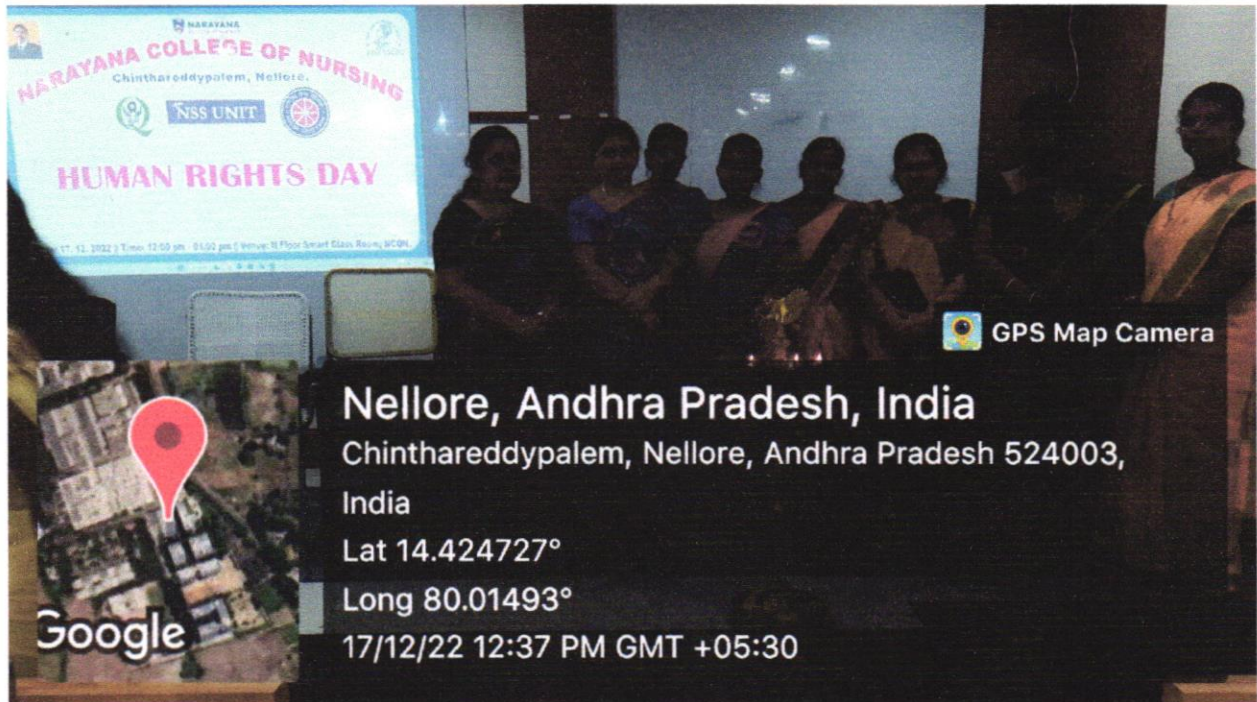


Fig 3: Lamp lighting by Dignitaries.

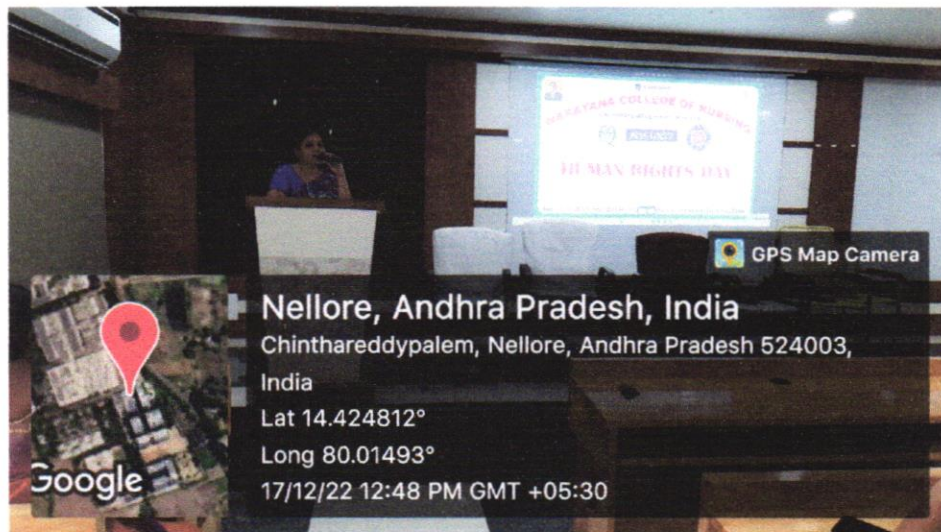


Fig 4: Speech given by prof. Vanaja Kumari

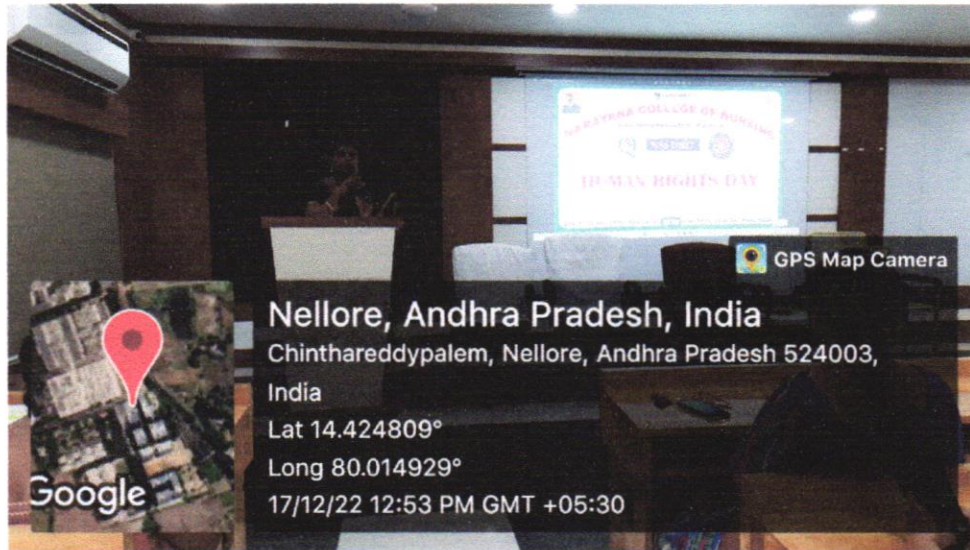


Fig 5: speech given by prof. Latha.
