group folk dances, poster presentations, and classical solo dances that had been recorded.

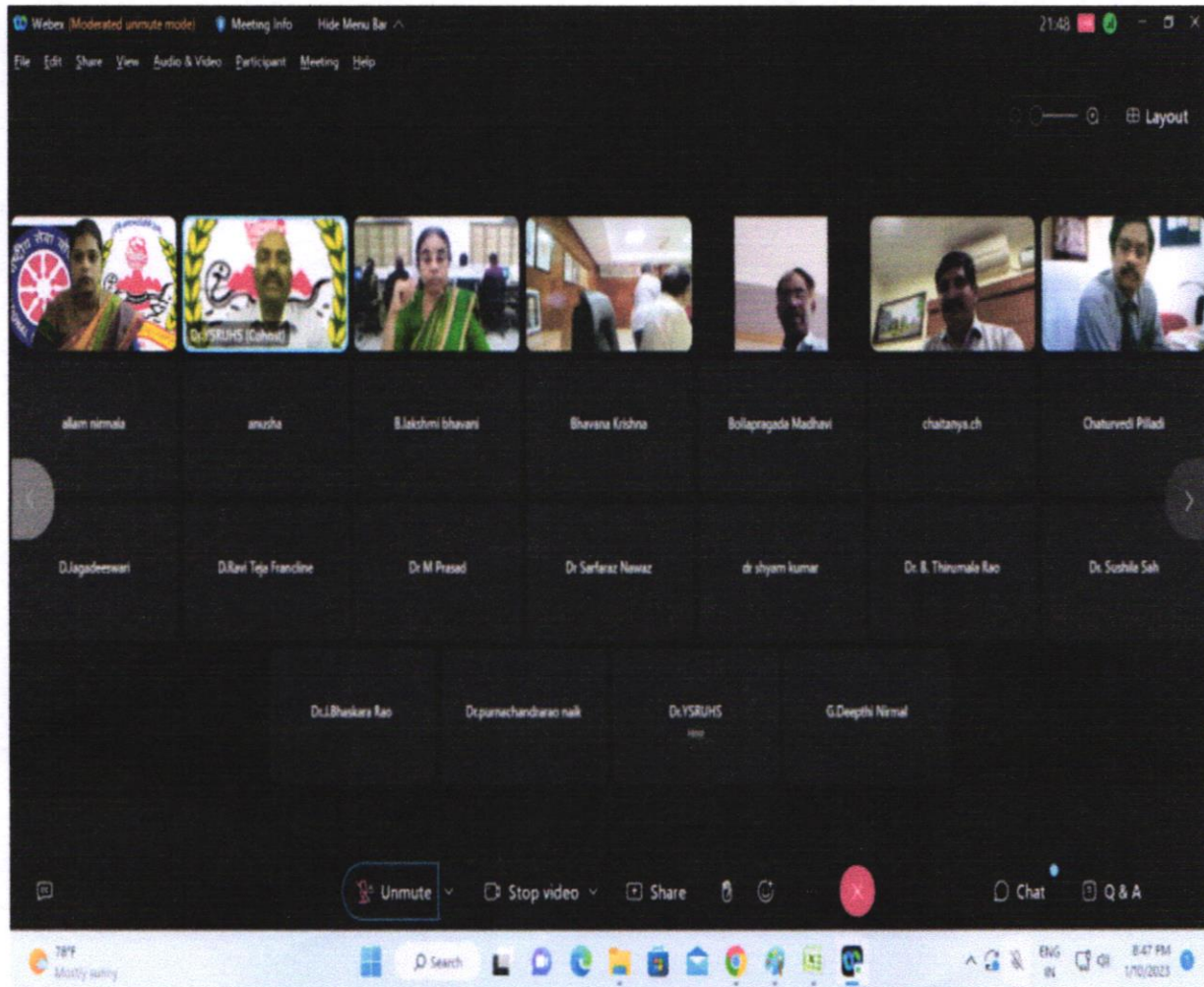


Fig 1: starting the youth festival online CISCO -WEBEX

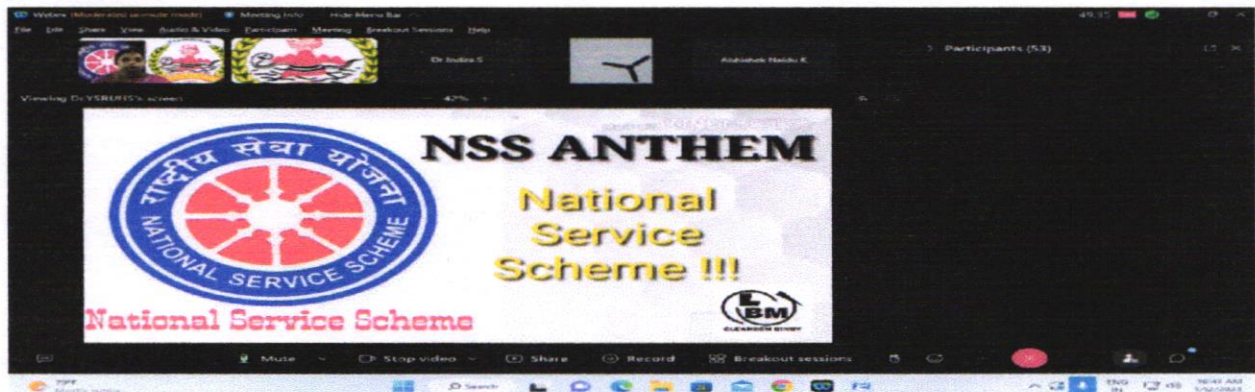


Fig 2: Displaying NSS Theme song
