





With regard to the level of knowledge ondiabetic dayamong participants, the pretest results shows that 10 (13.3%) scored "A" grade, 19 (25.3 %) participants scored "B+" grade, 20 (26.7%) participants scored "B" grade, 21 (28%)scored"C" grade. 5(6.7%) participants scored D grade and no participants scoredA+ and D. While in the post test, the knowledge level improved as 32(42.7%)participants scored "A+" grade, 26 (34.7 %) scored "A" grade, and 13 ( participants scored"B+" grade. 4(5.3%) scored grade 17.3%) of and there was no participants in C and D grades. The results indicate that participants level of knowledge on diabetes, its prevention and management had increased and participants were benefited from the program

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


Fig:3 comparison of pretest and post test scores on diabetic day
